#### From the Principal's Desk

I have just had confirmation that the building project at the school will commence on Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> January. The company engaged to complete the project is Moretto Building. They will start the first stage of the rebuild by refurbishing rooms 3 and 4 (Prep/1 and 2/3 classes) and building a new classroom on the eastern end of that wing. That means that the P/1 and 2/3 students will have to housed in alternative spaces, until the new classrooms are completed. Following that part of the rebuild, the next stage will be to refurbish the two senior classrooms (Rooms 1 and 2), and again, those two classes will need to be relocated until the new classrooms are completed. At this stage the temporary classroom spaces will be either the old portable, the library or the hall. Everything will be packed up and moved before the end of the school year, so the building works can commence on the 16<sup>th</sup>. Exciting times ahead.

#### **FUN RUN FUNDRAISER**

All of the students who raised money for the Fun Run received their prizes on Monday. The school raised \$2386.65 in total, which is a wonderful effort. A special mention goes to our P/1 class, who raised the most, with super congratulations to Zane Helmore-Keust and his family for raising over \$600 on their own.


