



How to save emails from Weblium Mail to your home computer

To save the archive of incoming letters, make a copy of it on your desktop computer.

You can use any services and email programs. Our instruction is prepared on the basis of a free mail client - **Thunderbird**. You can download it at <https://www.thunderbird.net/>

After installing the program, you will be prompted to enter the basic settings:

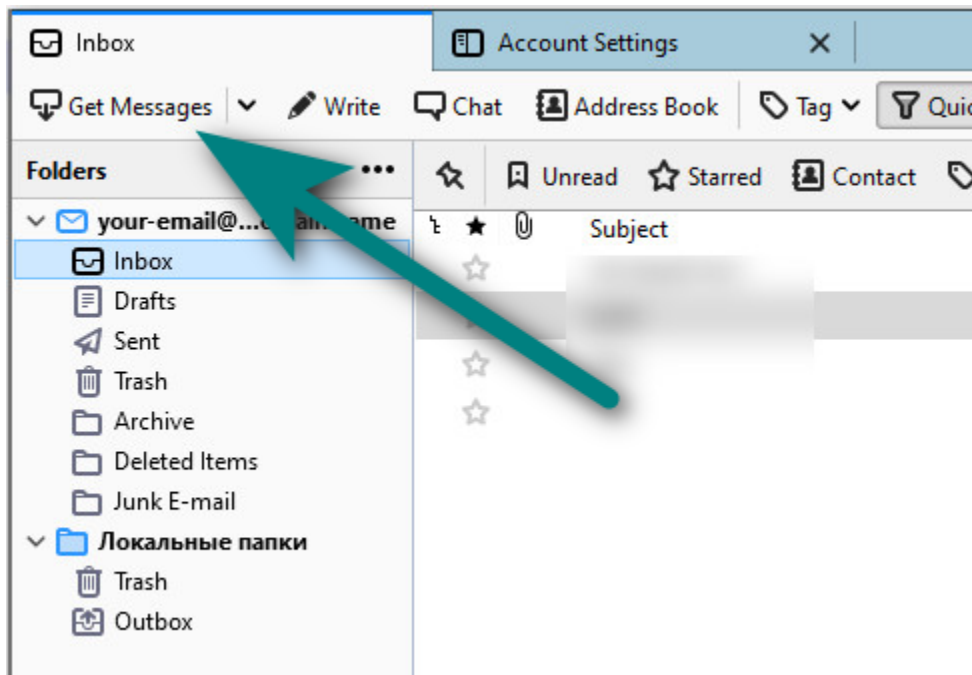

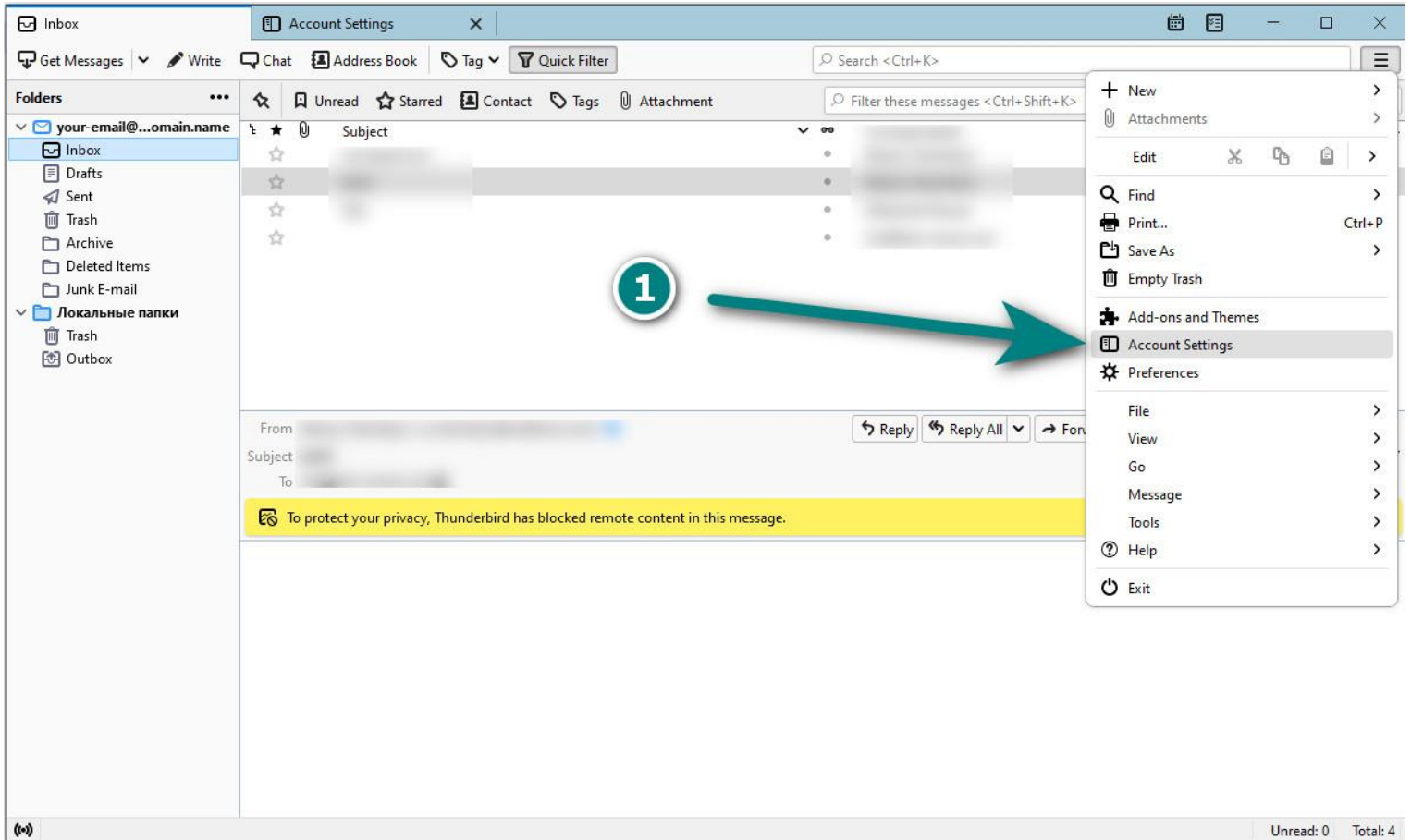
Enter the suggested settings and click "**Done**"

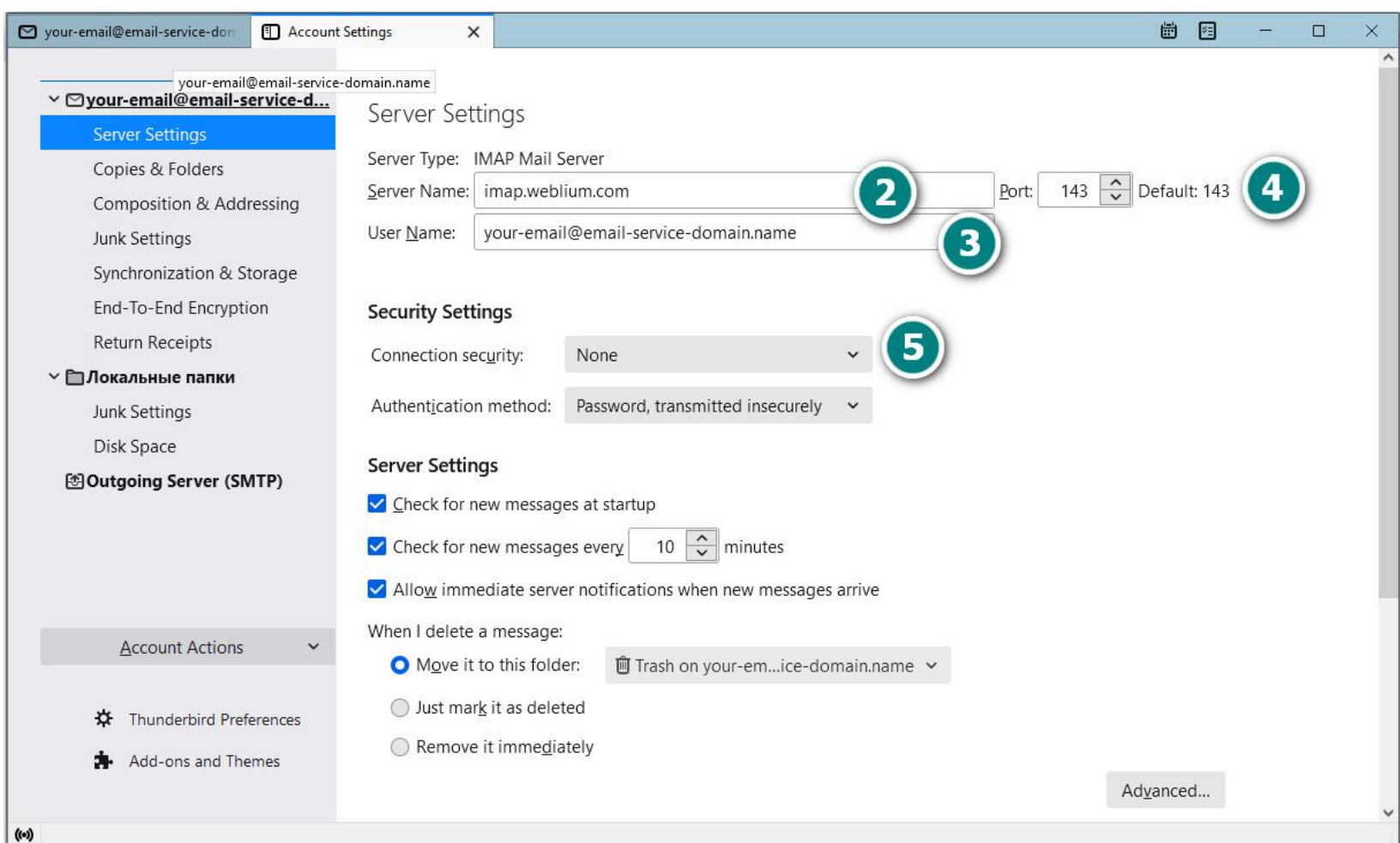
After making the settings, click on "**Get messages**". That's it, your messages are yours.
