#### **TOURISM IN THE TIME OF COVID-19**

NCN Health is excited to welcome back visitors from around Victoria and interstate this summer with a strong focus on keeping the community

Part of our COVID Safe plan for tourism includes health promotion and education for visitors to our region and providing free COVID-19 swab testing to anyone with symptoms.

#### What can the community do?

We all have a role to play in protecting our communities from COVID-19, while still enjoying a festive Christmas season.

Lead by example - always follow the public health advice staying 1.5m away from others, regularly washing and sanitizing your hands and if you feel unwell with symptoms of COVID-19 isolate in your home or accommodation and arrange to get tested.

Encourage your visitors to be proactive - if you notice a family or friend has any of the following symptoms; fever, chills or sweats, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of the sense of taste, loss of the sense of smell, or fatigue or tiredness for no identified reason, suggest they take it seriously and arrange to get a COVID-19 swab test at NCN Health or contact their CP.

Ensure family and friends isolate until the results are returned. The time it takes to get your COVID-19 results back can vary depending on the demand for testing, however they usually take between 1–3 days.
