NEW STAFF

SCHOOL CHAPLAIN

I am excited to announce the appointment of Mrs Wendy Rowan as the School Chaplain, a position funded by the Federal Government through the National Schools Chaplaincy Program. Wendy's role is to provide welfare support and pastoral care to all our students, as well as their families. The NSCP program guidelines clearly state that Chaplains are **not** to preach or offer religious guidance, so Wendy is **not** a Religious Education instructor and will only be providing pastoral care. She will be available for students to talk to as a counsellor, and is skilled in assisting parents, carers and families as well. There is a consent form that all parents need to sign in order for Wendy to offer her support to your child if needed.

SCHOOL STREAM APP

In order to make it easier for us to communicate with you, with notices, information and alerts, we have purchased the **School Stream** app to streamline the whole process.

On this app we can put all our permission notes for excursions etc. and you can sign them electronically and send them back (no more forgotten notices in the bottom of your child's school bag!). Our newsletter will also be posted there, as well as lunch order menus. You can also use it to record a student absence. Importantly, if we need to contact all our parents in an emergency situation, it will generate an immediate alert for everyone.

Leanne has posted information on our Facebook page, explaining how to download this app. Many parents have already joined, and I would encourage all parents/carers to take advantage of this great communication tool. We need everyone on it, to make it truly effective.

EXCURSION TO COBRAM

4. Tap the INSTALL button

5. Enter your Apple ID and password & OK

6. Wait for the install icon to change to OPEN & Tap the OPEN button

7.Accept push notifications, you will need to select OK

8.Start typing your school into the search Strathmerton Primary School & SELECT
