Attendance

Regular attendance at school is an extremely important indicator of student performance. The Department of Education and Training suggests that even as few as 5 or 6 days absence in a school year can have an adverse effect on a student's progress. The DET monitors the absence rate of students across the State and will contact schools to discuss their attendance strategies where that rate is unsatisfactory.

Strathmerton PS has always had a high level of attendance, however it's disappointing to note that we have many 'unexplained absences' at the moment, where the child is not at school, and we haven't been informed why. We know that currently there is a great deal of 'flu-like' illness in the area, but in most cases the parents/carers have either let us know through the Compass app or phoned the school. When we haven't seen a student for several days and haven't been able to make contact, we become quite concerned.

There is no excuse for a student to be absent from school without explanation. If your child is absent from school, please let us know via Compass or phone call, as every 'unexplained absence' is recorded against their name. 'It's not OK to be away!'

- · workshops and group activities to build your skills and make connections

Our peer wellbeing workers are available to people seeking support. Many of these people have their own experience of mental health challenges or are caring for someone with mental health issues.

People of all ages with new or existing mental health challenges can utilise services at the Hub.

Services are also available to family members and carers.

Referrals can be informal and all services are free of charge.
