On families and education: As a mother of two young kids, Richards knows how important healthy parenting and support structures are. She is committed to both envisioning and funding more diverse recreational options for families with varying developmental needs as well as working with the schools to make sure each child is reading at grade level by the time they reach third grade. The end result of this, Richards believes and research has shown, is a decline in poverty, an increase in graduation rates, and children developing a line of sight from where they currently are to the career they dream of having.

On housing: Having worked in human resources for over a decade, Richards has interacted with job-seekers from many walks of life, including those who have grown up in environments where access to basic necessities was lacking. Because of this, and because of the relationships

she has developed with many residents from various parts of Little Rock, Richards is committed to providing ways for all people to have access to safe and affordable housing, and for those of every socio-economic level to be welcomed and included.

"Little Rock is a city ripe with possibilities," Richards explains. "As I look to serve the city well in this position, I will work tirelessly to cultivate those possibilities so that we can provide a better future for all residents of our city."
