In 2020, Olivier and Ferdinand partnered with David Faivre, a winegrower in Belval-sous-Châtillon, to purchase 4,000 kg of grapes. The wines were vinified and bottled in the heart of Avize, then aged on laths for 2 years. This clay-limestone terroir on the surface, with sandy-silt soils in depth, offers an elegant expression of the village of Belval-sous-Châtillon and its Pinot Meuniers.

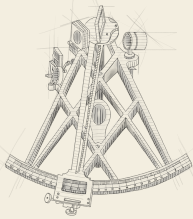

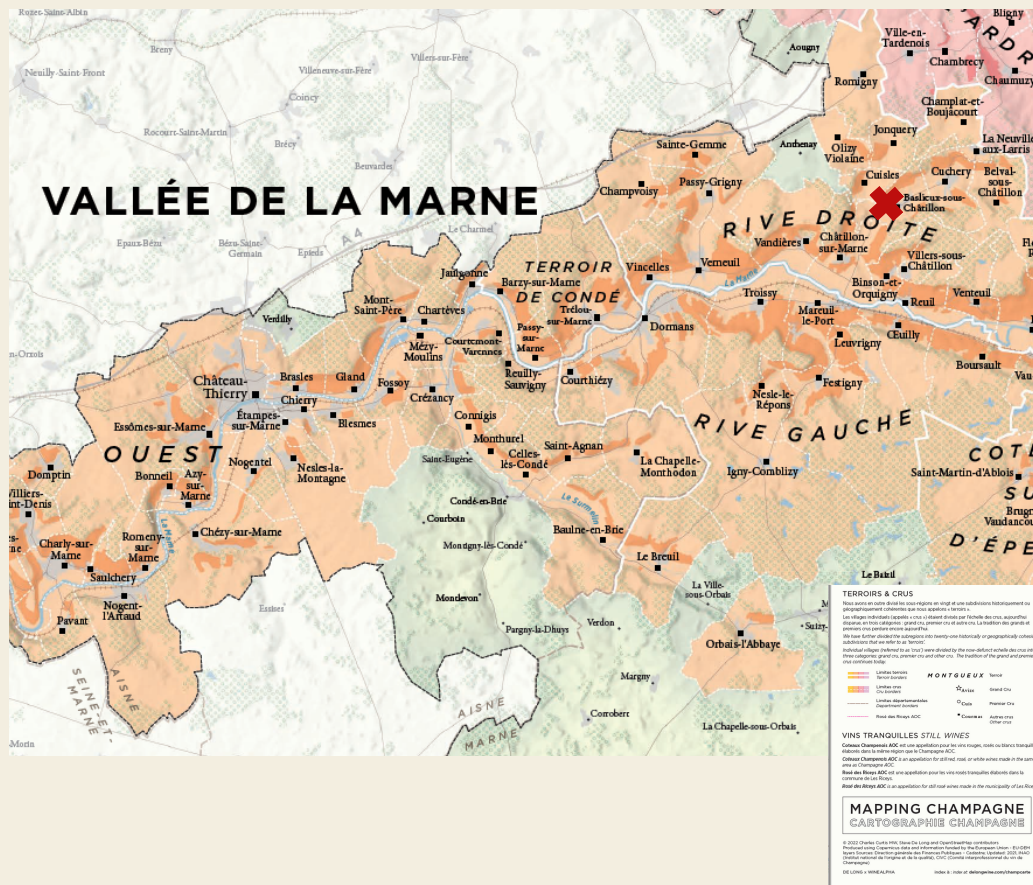
