UAlbany Gardenway	University of Albany Uptown Campus, Albany, NY	Purple	November 2021	May 2023	The UAlbany Gardenway is a dedicated busway for the Purple Line through the UAlbany Uptown campus. Upgrades include a new BRT station, traffic signal upgrades, and pedestrian improvements to the campus and surrounding area.	
Brevator and Belvidere Roadway Improvements	Brevator Street, Albany, NY	Purple	May 2022	September 2022	CDTA will be constructing new dedicated bus lanes to access the Harriman Campus along with a new traffic signal at Brevator, pedestrian improvements, and a new multi-use path along the bridge over NY-85.	
Albany Bus Garage	110 Watervlie Ave, Albany, NY	Purple	April 2019	November 2021	CDTA constructed a new bus garage in preparation for the rollout of the Purple Line. The garage features upgraded facilities included a new bus wash and hydraulic lifts for articulated buses.	
Allen BRT Station	Allen St & Western Ave, Albany, NY	Purple	June 2022	May 2023	CDTA will be constructing a new Purple Line BRT station at the intersection of Allen St and Western Ave. In addition to a new station, CDTA will be implementing traffic signal upgrades, pedestrian improvements, and roadway repaving.
