Destruction

as a result of rocket attacks

As a result of military aggression the **City of Dnipro** suffered the **destruction of civil and critical infrastructure**, many people died and many more were injured

April 10, 2022



Destroyed airport «Dnipro» and infrastructure nearby

July 15, 2022



The enemy missile destroyed the city's infrastructure and buildings. Several people died

September 11, 2022



Destruction of the historical buildings of the city center

September 29, 2022



The Russian "Iskander" destroyed an enterprise transporting citizens in the Dnipro

September 29, 2022



The ruins of a bombed-out private house in Dnipro where the whole family died

November 26, 2022



The enemy missile hit the private sector, causing massive destruction

Destruction

as a result of rocket attacks

In Dnipro, a rocket hit a 9-storey residential building, killing at least **46 people** and injuring at least 80. Another 11 people remain missing.



A residential apartment building was struck by an X-22 class missile



Among the killed were – 6 children and teenagers;
among the injured are – 16 children, including two in critical condition

Large-scale destruction at the site of the explosion, part of the building was destroyed, hundreds of apartments were damaged and will require reconstruction.



Social prerequisites

Among the IDPs (internally displaced persons) who are currently in the City of Dnipro, **40% plan to stay** after the end of hostilities.



In Dnipro (officially)
190 000 persons.

Plan to stay

75 000 persons.

Of them require:

Housing – **53 % (16 500 apartments)**

Job – **34 % (25 500 workplaces)**

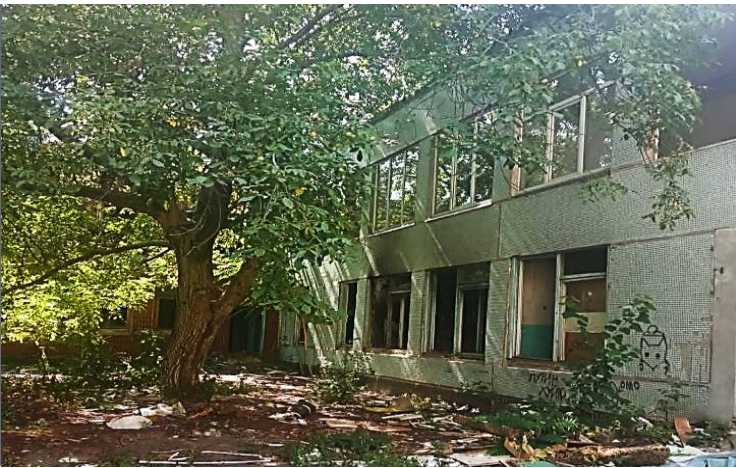

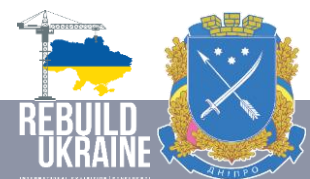

Social significance of the project:

- Construction of housing - 250 apartments (730 people)
- "Chronomisto" - work + housing + recreation in one area within walking distance.
- The area of land plots for residential and public development is 10.0 ha.

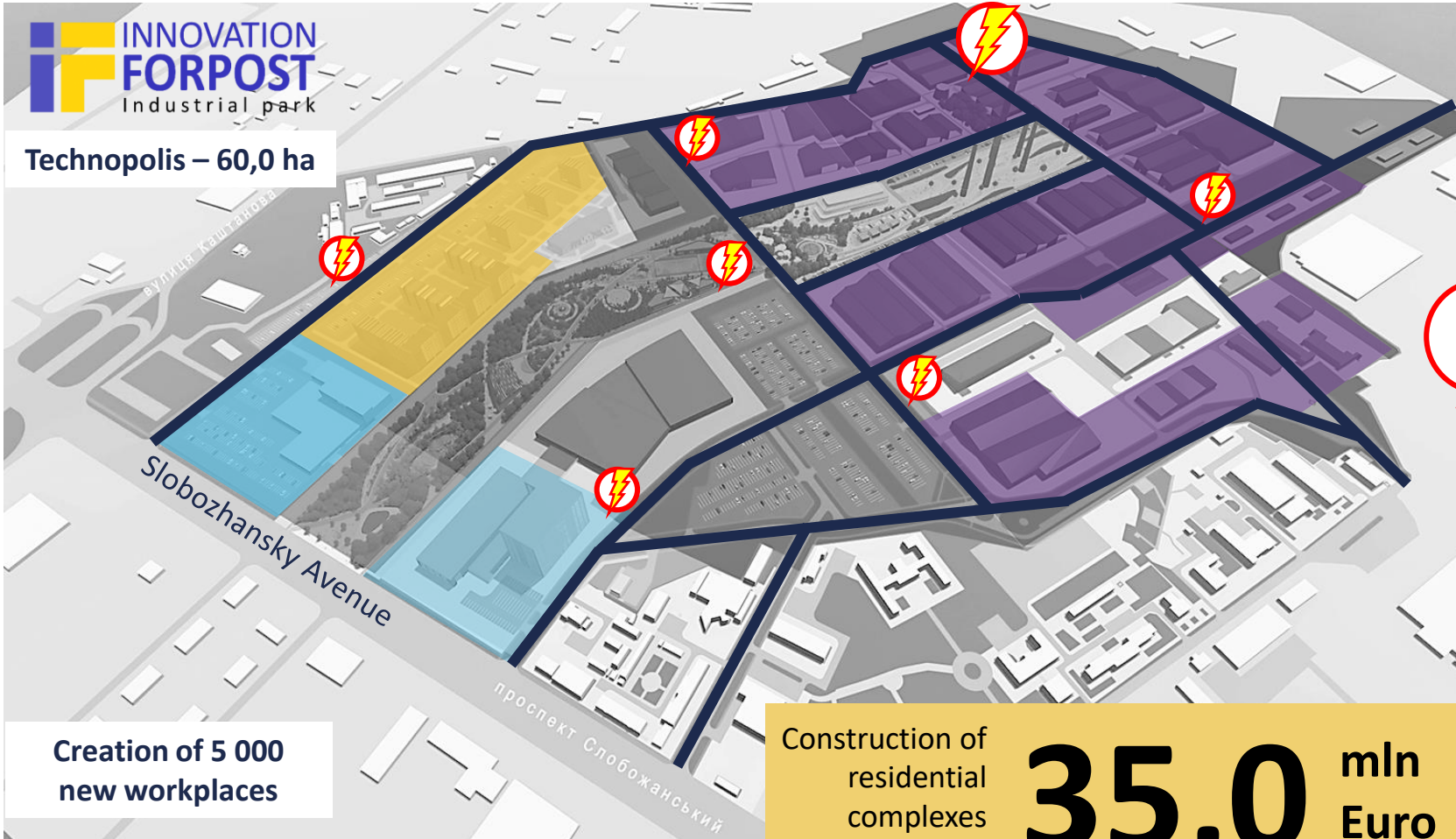
Technopolis - this is infrastructure, factories, residential and public complexes, a kindergarten and a green park in the city center. Communal (municipal) ownership

Construction of roads, water supply, sewerage **23,9** mln Euro

Construction of electricity supply, Substations, power 16.5 MW **9,3** mln Euro

Construction of 30 new ecological plants (enterprises) **20,0** mln Euro

Construction of public complexes (17 500 m²) **21,0** mln Euro

Construction of residential complexes (27 000 m²) **35,0** mln Euro



Complex development of the territory

Housing estate construction

Object address: Manuilivskiy ave. in the Amur-Nyzhnodniprovskiy district of the city of Dnipro



Social significance of the project:

1. Creating opportunities for IDPs to stay in the City rather than emigrate abroad or to the west of the country.
2. Ecological improvement:
 - Arrangement of canals as a dewatering system on flooded lands
 - Reduction of transport links due to the development of central territories.
3. Replenishment of the real estate market with high quality properties.
4. Creation of new jobs in office and commercial buildings, social infrastructure facilities.

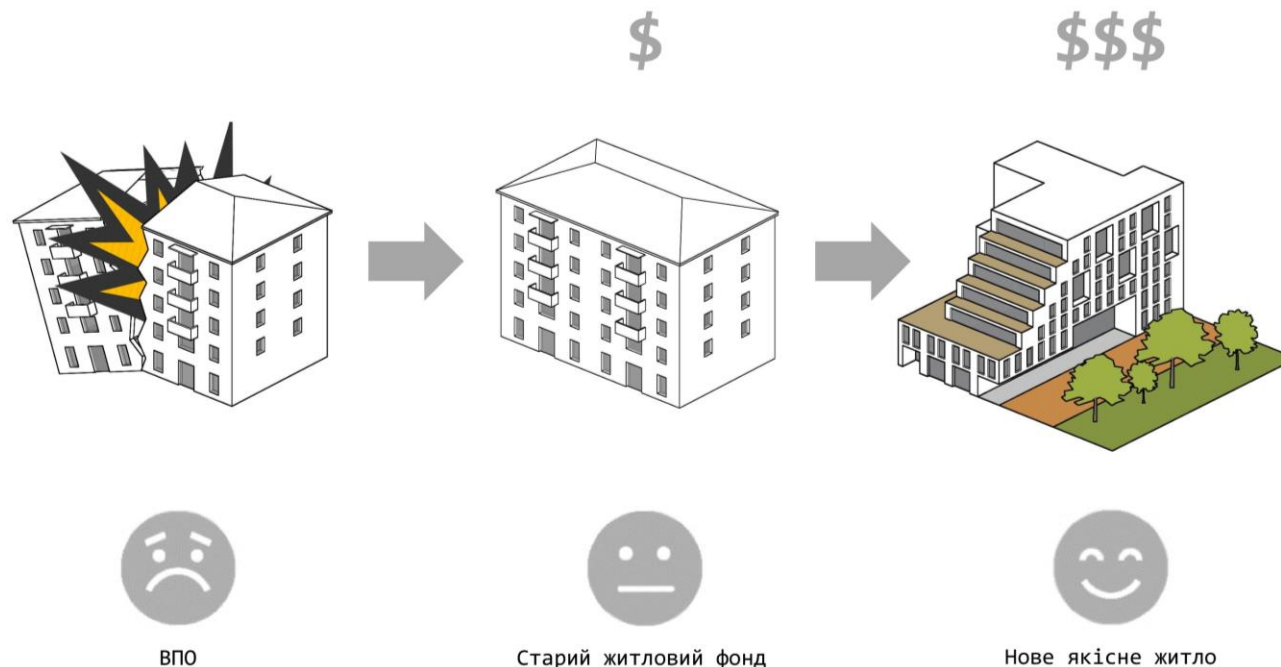
