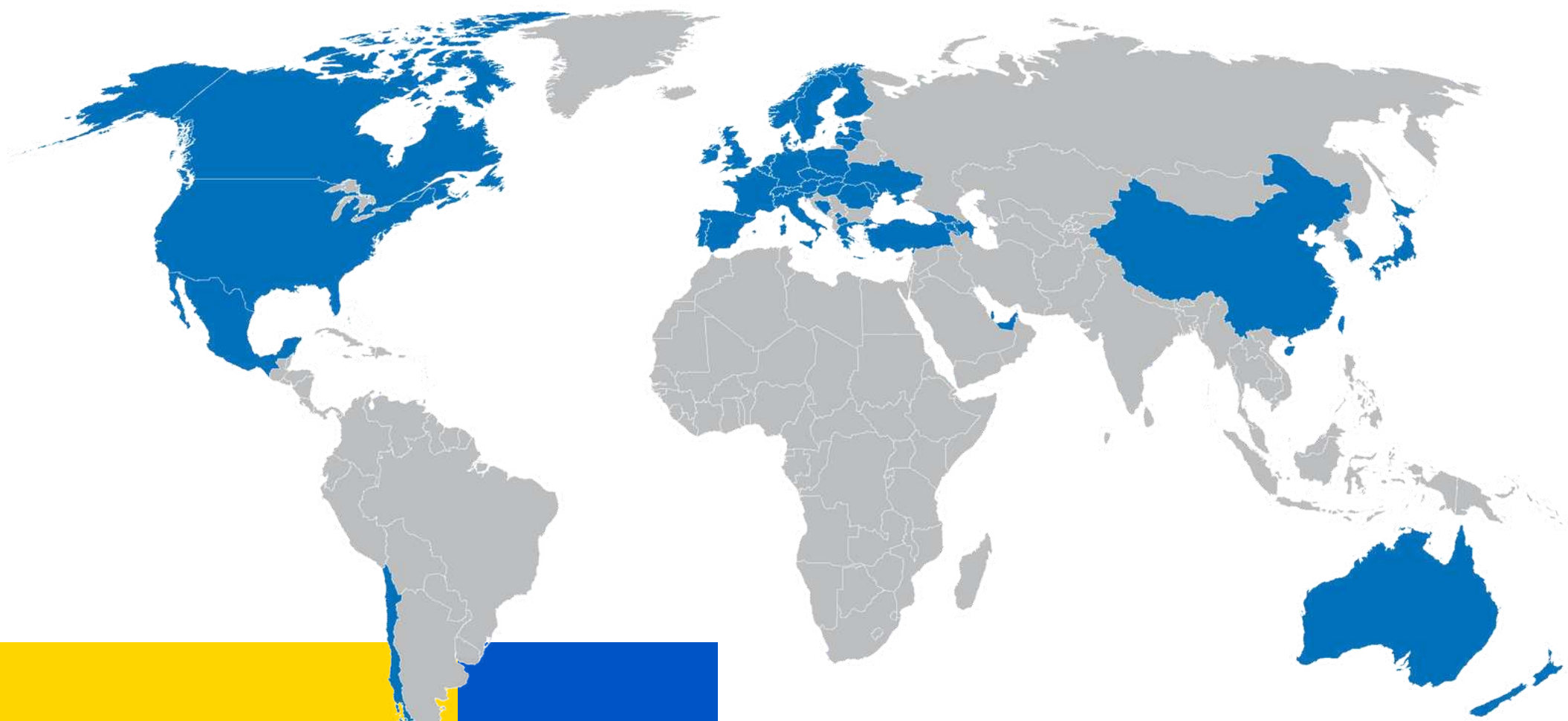

Speaking about reconstruction of Ukraine we are speaking about now – for today and yesterday and not to wait for huge reconstruction after the victory of Ukraine. We started the projects in Kyiv region such as school, kindergarten and all schools have to be friendly to children and teachers. We should act faster. Let's have the next event in Eastern part of Ukraine."

I am here to help demonstrate and deliver the UK's resolve for supporting Ukraine against Russia's illegal aggression. That commitment was reinforced last week, when the UK was honoured to welcome President Zelenskyy to the United Kingdom, on his first official trip to Europe since the full scale invasion. The UK will continue to stand shoulder to shoulder with Ukraine and has enthusiastically accepted Ukraine's invitation to participate in the country's recovery and reconstruction. Trade is one of the key ways in which we are doing this. It was in this spirit that we established the UK-Ukraine Infrastructure Taskforce, working with the Government of Ukraine to establish projects where we can match UK and Ukrainian expertise to rebuild critical infrastructure. We have also liberalised all tariffs on Ukrainian imports and agreed in November 2022 Ukraine's first ever Digital Trade Agreement to support Ukraine's economy now and into the future.

"The reconstruction cannot begin only after the war has come to an end. We need to look now at what can be repaired and rebuilt immediately: hospitals, schools, train stations and the energy infrastructure. And we must lay the foundations today for a peacetime economy where citizens can go about their daily lives in the cities and villages. This is not a utopian idea, but the concrete, tangible goal of Ukraine's struggle and our policy. This business exhibition is making a contribution to the defense of Ukraine; it helps to give strength and confidence to the Ukrainian people and to restore peace. My thanks and appreciation go to the team at "Premier Expo" from Kyiv, which developed the idea for this impressive event and organised it in a very short period of time. (...) I am very pleased that more than 50 companies and institutions from Germany are participating in the exhibition hosted as part of "REBUILD UKRAINE" together with our ministry. They all have lots of expertise and technologies that can make an important contribution to the reconstruction of Ukraine. (...)

"The German-Ukrainian Energy Partnership which was established before the war, but it also serves to support Ukraine in the current situation. For example, the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action has paid 100 million euros into the Ukraine Energy Support Fund of the European Energy Community, which can be used to buy technical equipment for the Ukrainian energy infrastructure. We are providing another 40 million euros to finance technical improvements to enable large-scale electricity trading with Ukraine. (...) In terms of the reconstruction of Ukraine, the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action sees itself as an 'enabler' of the economy. In other words, only if private investors get on board to rebuild Ukraine, will we be able to deliver what Ukraine needs. And only then will the country's reconstruction be sustainable, because it will allow for even greater integration of Ukraine into European value chains. We are supporting companies in their business activities in Ukraine by providing comprehensive information services and instruments to promote foreign trade and investment. (...) The German government will be a close partner for Ukraine and continue to support it on this path."

Billions of dollars worth of damage have been sustained by Ukraine as a result of this war, with around 100,000 houses being damaged by early summer last year. The residential sector is the most affected, with housing accounting for 40% of the billion-dollar damage.

The digital aspect of the reconstruction is under government control: 300,000 reports of property loss have already been registered through the Diya App. at the fundraising platform United24, and as of today we have raised approximately \$14 million for the reconstruction of Ukraine.
