Our website, www.opora.uk and all applicable sub-domains, (our "site") uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our site. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our site and also allows us to improve our site. By continuing to browse our site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookie may be present only for the duration of your visit to our site or they may be persistent for the duration of your internet usage or of longer duration where they relate to providing a customised browsing experience of service for you on our site.

What cookies do we use?

We use the following cookies on our site for the purposes described:

- Google Analytics: helps Opora website owners measure how users interact with website content. As a user navigates between web pages, Google Analytics provides website owners JavaScript tags (libraries) to record information about the page a user has seen, for example the URL of the page. This helps Opora
 - o Determine which domain to measure
 - o Distinguish unique users
 - o Remember the number and time of previous visits
 - o Remember traffic source information
 - o Determine the start and end of a session

Most internet browsing software will allow you to control the acceptance and storage of cookies. You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser menu that allows you to refuse the setting for all or some cookies.
