The daily work of hospitals today requires constant adaptation to new challenges: power outages, staff overload, workforce shortages, lack of technology, and a growing number of complex cases.

We encounter these challenges directly, in conversations with doctors, during visits to medical facilities, and through the specific requests submitted to the Foundation. Often, these requests concern basic necessities without which proper treatment cannot be provided. Our role is to listen to the real needs of medical teams and help address them where support is critically needed.

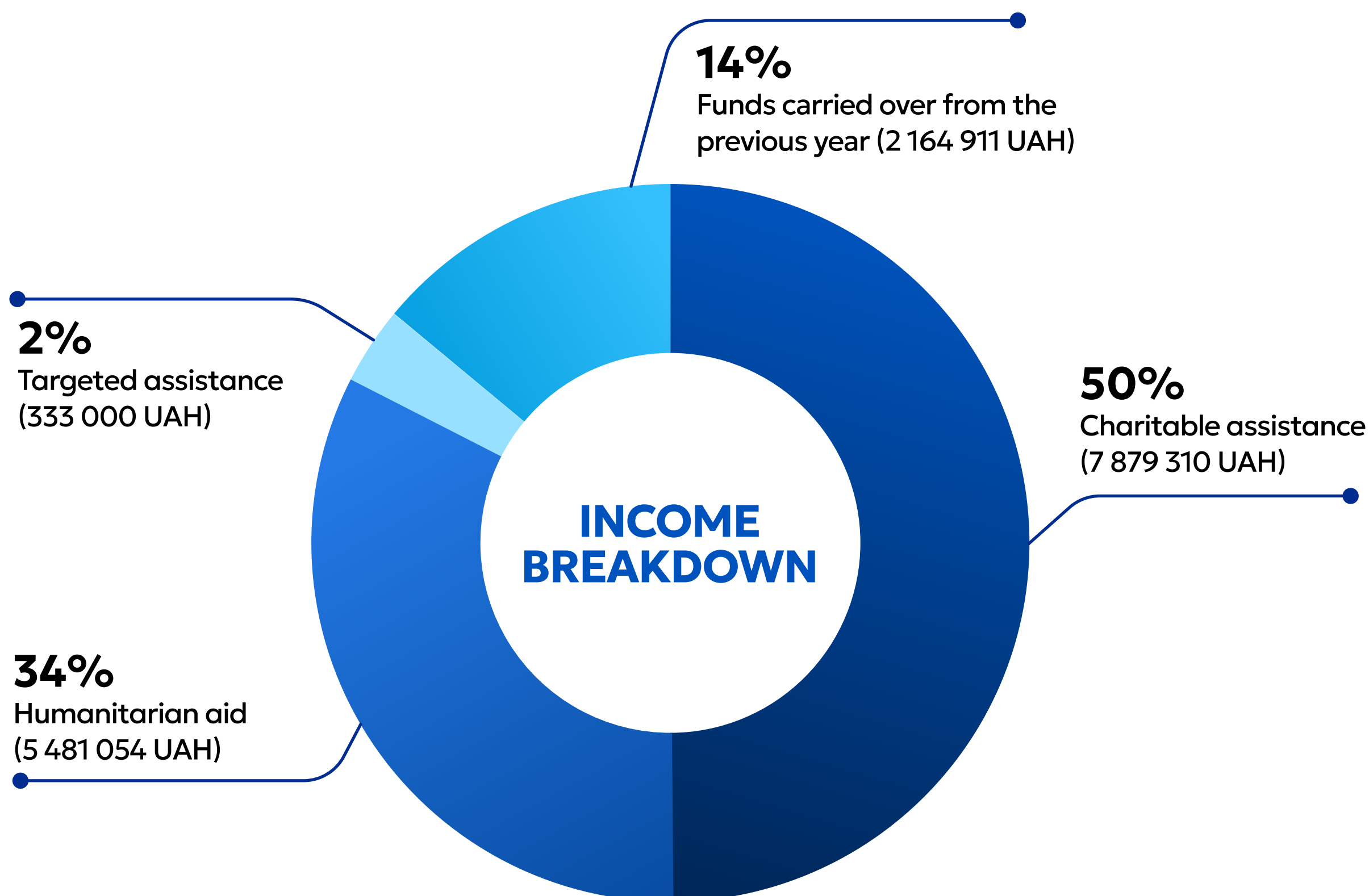

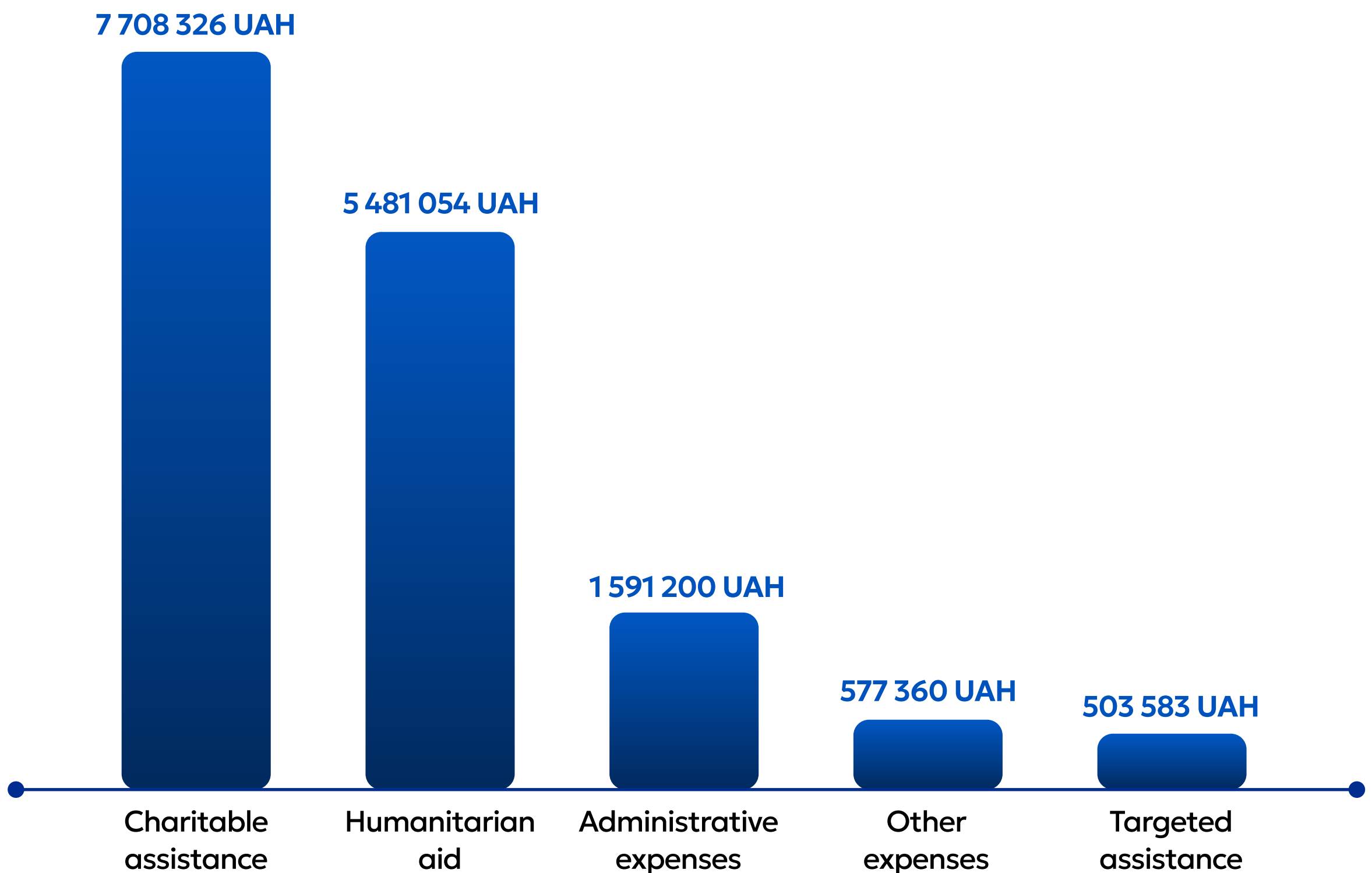

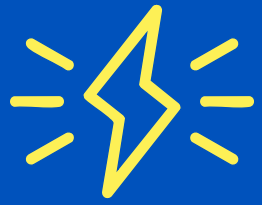


INCOME AND EXPENDITURES FOR 2024

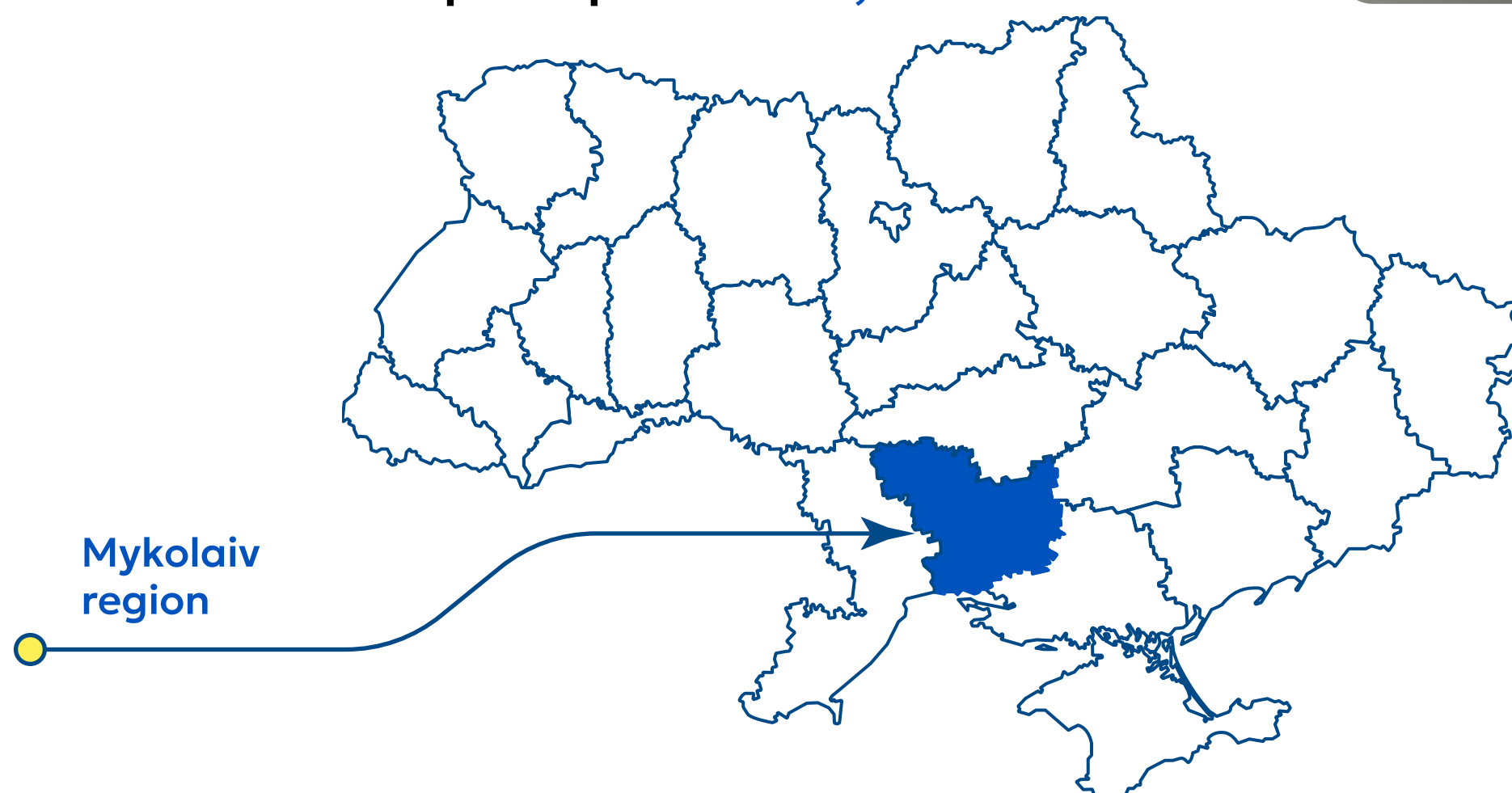
MYKOLAIV REGIONAL ONCOLOGY CENTER CASE

A pilot project was implemented

Mykolaiv Regional Oncology Center is a 257-bed hospital providing care for people across the South of Ukraine and admitting patients from Mykolaiv, Kherson, Odesa, Zaporizhzhia, and Kharkiv regions.

AS A RESULT:

- Autonomous power supply for the operating unit and the intensive care unit
- Uninterrupted surgeries during blackouts
- Annual savings of over **UAH 0.5 million**
- Environmental impact equivalent to **1,200 trees**



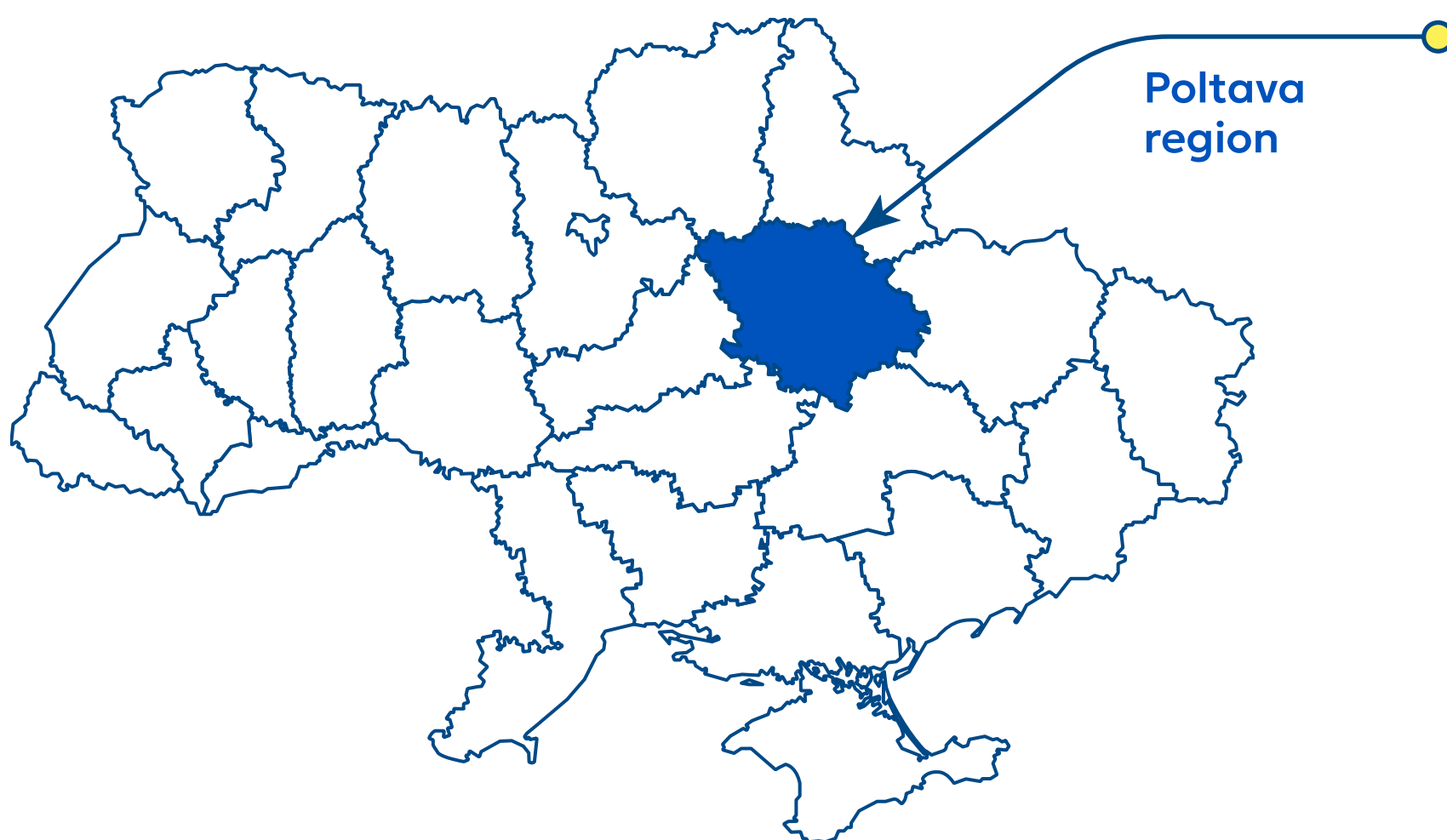
SETTING UP OPERATING AND PROCEDURE ROOMS



In 2024, the Foundation continued to develop its work on upgrading operating theatres and procedure rooms in medical facilities, focusing on creating safe, functional, and modern conditions for surgeries and patient care in regions where the healthcare system is under significant pressure.

LUBNY INTENSIVE CARE HOSPITAL CASE

Lubny Intensive Care Hospital is a 365-bed facility in Poltava region with a predominantly surgical and intensive care profile (60%). Each year, around 3,700 surgeries are performed there, providing care to civilians, internally displaced persons, and wounded service members. Through the joint efforts of the Foundation's team and donors, an additional operating theatre was equipped in line with modern standards.



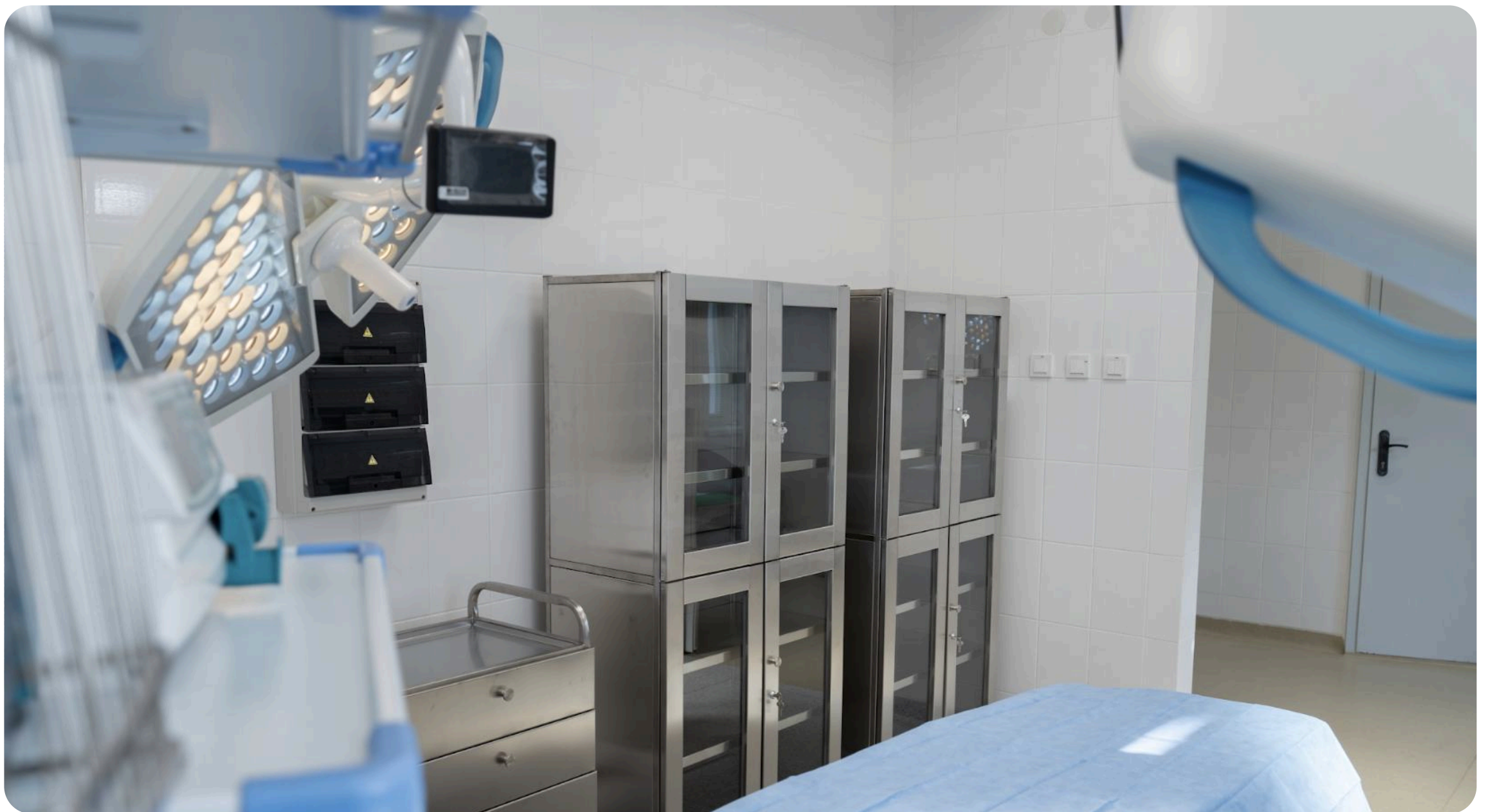

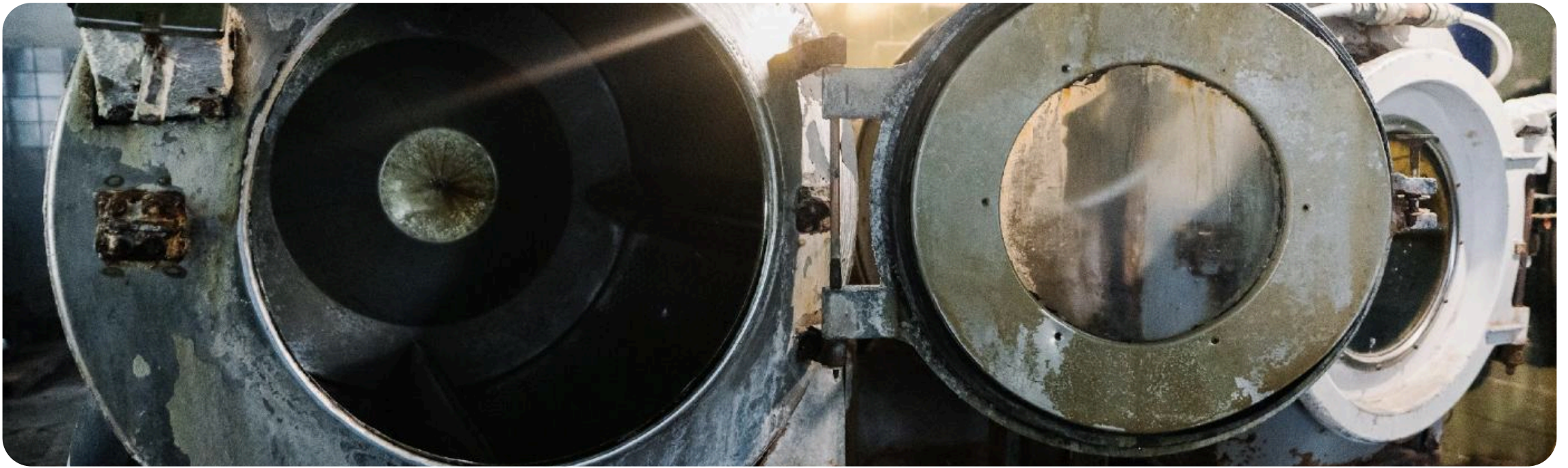
