Streams of work with direct impact on the rebuilding and Ukraine integration

1. New European Bauhaus – Life funding (*projects to help rebuild Ukraine and foster sustainable construction skills in Europe*)
2. Horizon Europe – potential for UA partners to be part of a consortium
3. Enterprise Europe Network (EEN) and Ukrainian Cluster Alliance
4. Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs (EYE) open for UA participants
5. EU – Ukraine Solidarity Lanes

Streams of work with direct impact on the rebuilding and Ukraine integration

6. Revised action plan for enhanced implementation of the EU-Ukraine DCFTA
7. Export Credit Guarantees
8. Standardisation – discussions to support UA national bodies
9. Construction Products Regulation
10. SME Fund extended to support UA businesses

On-going rebuilding – good examples

1. Focus on structural works: rebuilding infrastructure, energy and water networks but also including schools and housing
2. Cooperative processes including donor institutions, (local) authorities and experts
3. Re-use of materials and innovation – rebuilding Ukraine as a catalyst

Important considerations

1. Public procurement – access and transparency
2. Efficient use of public money – project cost assessments and validation checks
3. Asbestos – health of construction workers / citizens

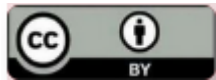
