

Individual houses

The complex offers 123 individual residential buildings that provide comfort and privacy for IDP families. The houses are built to modern standards, taking into account the needs of the residents.



Multi-apartment buildings

The 31 apartment buildings provide affordable housing for various categories of IDPs, including young families, pensioners and single people. The apartments are equipped with comfortable kitchens, bathrooms and bedrooms.
