- establishing cooperative relations with small businesses specializing in services (transportation of workers and goods, marketing, advertising, printing, development services, etc.).



Financial indicators

Estimated cost of the project: 120 mln. USD

Return on investment: 28%

Payback period: 5-6 years

Economic indicators

The cost of glass of 4 mm with delivery:

6-8 thousand USD for sq.m (2 USD out of it – delivery)

Planned market price: 4,5 USD for sq.m.

Number of employees: 450 people

Area of new construction: 45 thousand sq.m

Energy demand

- 100 thousand cubic meters of gas per day
- 10 MW of installed electric capacity

Transport accessibility

5 km - Kyiv-Kharkiv-Dovzhanske M-03 **0,82 km** - to the train station «Berezan» South-West railway **0,35 km** - railway

Utilities and communications (water supply, sewerage, gas supply, electricity supply) - absent, but there are entry points within a distance of 300-350 meters.

Benefits – the land plot belongs to the industrial land defined by the General Plan of Berezan and the Detailed Plan of the territory. Target purpose - 11.02. For placement and operation of main, auxiliary and support buildings and structures of processing, machine-building and other industries


Transport accessibility

70 km - on east from Kyiv city,

8 km - to the highways <u>E-40, M-03</u> (Kyiv – Kharkiv). There is a highway right next to the industrial park <u>T1024</u>, that is overlooking highways of international importance <u>E-40, M-03</u>

1 km - to the train station «Berezan» (322801) 30 km - to the international airport Boryspil

Benefits - the IP was included in the Register of Industrial Parks on January 30, 2020. In accordance with Ukrainian legislation, its participants have tax and customs benefits. As part of the state program to stimulate industrial parks, an application was submitted for compensation for the costs of connecting to the power grid.







The implementation of the building materials cluster will contribute to the development of industry in the region and will ensure long-term economic growth



The Berezan territorial community, taking into account the possibility of using an industrial land plot at 44-A Berezansky Shlyakh Street in Berezan city, planned to create a cluster of building materials.

Manufacturers of glass and other building products may join this cluster.


