- The Utility Platform finances Water Operator Partnerships Worldwide & Solidarity Operator Partnerships with Ukraine
- The partnerships work on various technical and administrative topics, such as water loss reduction, energy efficiency, water quality management, digitalization, waste reduction and more.
- The Utility Platform:
 - finances partnerships,
 - ensures connection to other development cooperation projects,
 - supports implementation and monitoring,
 - offers networking events, further trainings and knowledge exchanges for the employees of partner companies.



GELSENWASSER, EMSCHER EGLV – LUKANGA (ZAMBIA)

- Start of the partnership: 2021
- Rehabilitation of the pumping station at Mushimbili Dam in Kapiri Town serving 65,000 people.
- **Rehabilitation** and relaunch of an **elevated tank** in Chisamba town for over 15,000 people
- Relaunch of a wastewater treatment plant in Kapiri Moshi, which had been shut down for 10 years (for approx. 6,000 people)
- Improvement of the water loss strategy
- Installation of meters, improvement of the Geographic
 Information System (GIS) to manage and monitor the drinking water network
- Introduction of an asset management system.






WHAT ARE SOLIDARITY OPERATOR PARTNERSHIPS?



Focus of the solidarity operator partnerships in Ukraine: **Procurement of necessary technical equipment** and **accompanying peer-to-peer exchange** for the maintenance and sustainable organization of service provision and the rehabilitation of critical infrastructure.



12 OPERATOR PARTNERSHIPS IN UKRAINE



DRESDEN, BERLIN, COLOGNE - LVIV, TERNOPIL, NADVIRNA







- Start of the partnerships: Lvivvodokanal in 2021, Ternopilvodokanal and Nadvirnavodokanal: 2022
- Two weeks after the start of the full-scale war, a **relief convoy** with urgently needed generators and chemicals for water purification was organized for Lviv.
- Ukrainian delegations have been visiting **Germany** regularly, e. g. in June 2023 **female Ukrainian laboratory technicians participated** in a specialized laboratory course conducted by the German Regional Association Sachsen-Thüringen for Water, Wastewater and Waste.
- German partners are regularly procuring and donating essential equipment to their Ukrainian counterparts, including the recent donation of two suction vehicles.



HAMBURG WASSER – KYIVVODOKANAL







- Start of the partnership: August 2022
- Priorities: The optimization of the main water treatment plant in Kyiv, professional knowledge exchange on specific key topics such as Geographic Information Systems (GIS), hydraulic modeling and water loss reduction (non-revenue water).

• Following the recent Desna River pollution, HAMBURG WASSER swiftly supported its partner Kyivvodokanal by organizing and delivering urgently needed equipment **to prevent water contamination**, complemented by ongoing technical consultations.

OOWV - CHERNIHIV AND SUMY







- Start of the partnership: September 2022
- Since the beginning of the full-scale war, both Miskvodokanal (Sumy) and Chernihivvodokanal have been affected by Russian military attacks. Partnership with the OOWV aims to support in **rebuilding the destroyed water operator's infrastructure** through targeted **procurements.**
- In addition to procurements, the partnership also focuses on knowledge exchange within working groups with **regular visits in Germany**
- The newly established working group 'Drinking and Wastewater Laboratory' addresses a part that wasn't prioritized enough in Ukrainian plants before. The procurement of a gas and ion chromatograph for Sumy marks the first time the laboratory sector has received foreign support, with women primarily working with this equipment.



BONN-NETZ – KHERSONVODOKANAL



- Start of the partnership: **November 2023**
- The war-related challenges led to a targeted focus on necessary procurements. The city and critical infrastructure not only suffers damage from daily Russian attacks, but also suffered from the destruction of the Kakhovka dam.
- BonnNetz also donates materials from its own stock, including drinking water pumps and IT equipment such as laptops and monitors.
- A virtual exchange is planned to strengthen relationships and share experiences.

LOGISTICS HUB

- Start: January 2023 and active to date
- Objective: To provide additional support to Ukrainian water suppliers in times of war by delivering technical assistance provided by German water companies
- Organised by GIZ together with the Association of Municipal Enterprises (VKU) and financed by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ). The Ukrainian NGO 'Go Local' is in charge of the logistical processes.






DONATIONS AND PROCUREMENTS FOR UKRAINE


