


Swiss - Ukrainian cooperation

- Switzerland engaged in Ukraine since the 1990s
- Adaption and extension of projects since 2022
- <u>Strategic importance</u> for Swiss foreign policy
 - CHF 5 billion over 12 years (2025–2036)

Ukraine Country Programme 2025 - 2028

- CHF 1.5 billion for the next four years (2025–2028)
- Incl. CHF 500 million for the systematic inclusion of the Swiss private sector



Economic Cooperation

Contributes to Ukraine's economic stabilisation and reconstruction

- Strengthening <u>private sector development</u>, in particular SMEs and agriculture
- Supporting <u>transparent reconstruction of urban</u> <u>infrastructure</u>
- Strengthening the general framework for an <u>investment-friendly economy</u>
- Facilitating access to the EU single market



M2: 1st Call for Proposals

- CH companies with legal personality in UA; CHF 100 million, project contributions between 1–15
 CHF mio.
- Eligibility criteria: presence in UA, response to specific needs, own financial contribution
- Award criteria: relevance, impact on development, additionality, sustainability, ESG risks, technological suitability, implementation capacity, budget, own contribution
- ≈80 projects submitted by ≈60 companies; **12 projects selected** in the following areas:



Energy (Infrastructure Rehabilitation)



Housing



Humanitarian Demining



Health



Public Transport
