#### The main purpose

Create an industrial park to accommodate industrial, processing, innovation, logistics hubs and their related services

Provide economic development and enhance the competitiveness of the community

Develop modern manufacturing and market infrastructure, creating new jobs




#### **Key Characteristics:**

The Chernivtsi Industrial Park is included in the Register of Industrial Parks in accordance with the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated on October 22, 2024, No. 1029-r

The land area of the Chernivtsi Industrial Park is 17.276 hectares

#### **MAIN GOAL:**


To build a new terminal with a capacity of approximately 400 passengers per hour

#### Area:


**14,000 m<sup>2</sup>** (terminal building with auxiliary facilities)

#### **Priority Measures:**

- Increase the load-bearing capacity of the aerodrome pavement for operational use
- Enhance flight safety through the reconstruction and extension of the runway
- Improve aerodrome characteristics and operating minimums to enable reception of passenger planes with code 4C

We are considering co-financing through national and local budget programs in partnership with the private sector and international institutions

We are considering grants opportunities, including co-financing from the EU, the Ukrainian Fund for Social Investments (UFSI)

#### "Reconstruction of the Municipal Solid Waste Landfill"

#### **MAIN GOAL:**



Construction of a waste recycling plant

Attraction of investments from the EU, international donors, and through public-private partnership (PPP)

Ensuring sustainable development through the preservation of natural resources



#### **General Information**

The project provides for the creation of a modern sorting line and modernization of the waste disposal system on an area of 14.5 hectares

Sorting zone capacity – up to 43,000 tons per year

Strategic goal – to establish a full-cycle waste processing plant in Chernivtsi, including a line for industrial waste processing

#### **MAIN STAGES:**

### REBUILD UKRAINE ON THE ROAD TO URC'26


#### Stage 1

- Creation of a new waste sorting line integrated into the municipal solid waste disposal system
- Construction of two landfill sections with new storage areas and two unloading platforms on a site of approximately 14.5 hectares
- Establishment of a sorting zone with a capacity of up to 43,000 tons of waste per year for efficient sorting and reduction of landfill volume

#### Stage 2

Construction of a waste recycling plant based on the available capacities

#### **MAIN GOAL:**

Energy independence of the territorial community, development of a circular economy, reduction of landfill load, and a positive impact on the environment

#### **General Information:**

On April 30, 2025, an agreement was signed between Swedfund International AB, Municipal Enterprise "Chernivtsiteplokomunenergo", and SWECO International AB to develop the feasibility study for the project

Thermal power plant is planned to be located near the "Pivdenna-3" boiler house, which will supply heat to approximately 29,000 residents as well as multiple institutions and enterprises







CapEx –  $\le$  62,35 million Co-finanace – 40 % IRR  $\approx$  19,5 % Profitability – 1,08 %


