JOBS


The creation of over **3,000** new jobs is expected.


Weighted average rate between Government Bonds and Investor's Funds

PSYCHIATRIC CARE


Diagnosis and treatment of combat-related mental health disorders, rehabilitation programs with psychiatrists and psychotherapists
