During the course you will learn PM approaches, tools and techniques, as well as reveal the role of project managers, their interaction with team and key project stakeholders, change and risk management.

The course is designed for practitioners to identify the right approach not only to get the job done, but to deliver value.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Project management approaches, models, methods, tools and techniques are introduced in this course. Students will discover the project life cycle and learn how to deliver value from project initiation to completion. You will learn to:

- · Develop the skills to clearly define the scope and objectives of a project
- · Identify the necessary resources for each project activity or work package
- Develop the skills to create a comprehensive project plan that encompasses all necessary tasks, resources, timelines, and dependencies
- Understand the risk management process, including the identification, assessment, and mitigation of potential risks that may impact project success
- Acquire the ability to monitor and control project execution, implementing appropriate measures to track progress, address issues, and maintain project alignment with objectives
- Comprehend the structure and requirements of a capstone project defense presentation.



COURSE OUTCOMES:

The course is designed for individuals, business owners and top-managers who wish to learn Operations Management to:

- · Understand differences between processes, projects and tasks
- Choose appropriate project management approach depending on the ambiguity
- · Define project scope and objectives
- Breakdown project objectives into concrete activities/work packages and identify the resources needed for each of them
- Acquire, develop and manage project team
- · Identify and engage project stakeholders
- Control project execution.
