






Madama Isabella Altini:


Lady Lavinia Balthazar:

For the recording of the series, the Lazio region was chosen for its logistical benefits and for its setting that perfectly suits the medieval ambiance of the plot. The scene takes place in a picturesque room lit by candles and skylights, specially constructed for the series. At the center of the room is a large rectangular table, around which our five characters gather to share their stories and knowledge.

For the various contributions of scholars and specialists, it was necessary to conduct interviews in different locations that evoke the subjects analyzed. These locations include museums, offices, studios, and palaces
