Grammar: Nominative case; relative clauses in the nominative.

Topic 2: Feelings & Emotions

Find the words to express how you feel.

Grammar: Dative case.

Topic 3: Family Relationships

Talk about family and relationships.

Grammar: Accusative case.

Topic 4: Food for Thought

Expand your vocabulary for talking about food.

Grammar: Genitive case.

Topic 5: Eating Out

Practise the language you need for dining out.

Grammar: Indeclinable nouns, adverbs of frequency, and revision.

Topic 6: Living in the City

Describe places and talk about city life.

Grammar: Locative case.

Topic 7: Daily Routines & Household Chores

Talk about your schedule and everyday responsibilities.

Grammar: Time expressions using the nominative, genitive, accusative, and locative cases.

Topic 8: Transport & Professions

Talk about how you travel and what people do for work.

Grammar: Instrumental case.
