Founded in 1963, the club began as a loose gathering of friends enjoying casual matches on the Saffron Lane Recreation Field—a place that quietly lent its name to their emerging team. Among those early pioneers was Bob King, whose dedication has never wavered; decades later, he remains a cornerstone of the organisation, now serving as treasurer and secretary.

By 1976, the club's ambitions had outgrown its original setting, prompting a move to Cambridge Road. There, they rented a pitch from Wellington Vics, a partnership that shaped the club's early competitive years. When Wellington Vics folded in 1984, the ground passed fully into the hands of SDFC, giving the club a permanent home for the first time.

The mid-1990s marked another step forward as SDFC entered the Leicestershire Senior League in 1994. What began as a single senior side soon evolved into a thriving development structure, with youth teams steadily added until the club boasted squads from the Under-5s through to the Under-18s.

A major milestone arrived in 2011 when the club secured funding for a new clubhouse, transforming the matchday experience for players and supporters alike. This investment signalled a new era of ambition both on and off the pitch.

In recent years, progress has continued with the installation of a modern 7v7 3G surface and a surge in first-team performance. Their efforts culminated in promotion to the United Counties League after finishing runners-up in the Leicestershire Senior League during the 2018–19 season, a proud achievement in the club's unfolding story.
