### Scholarship Programmes at kma'pro





## **Objectives of the Scholarship Programmes:**

- 1. To provide additional value by offering access to quality education at NaUKMA for talented Ukrainians in need of support;
- 2. To establish a platform for good deeds, so that the names of the great are not forgotten, and their virtues are reflected in the scholarship recipients;
- 3. To create opportunities from employers and influencers for Ukraine's recovery and development through formal education (Bachelor's, Master's, and PhD programmes) and non-formal education (reskilling and professional growth programmes) at kma'pro.

## Why Does This Matter to You?

- You may be supporting **your future best employee**.
- A scholarship recipient is not a random person in your life. Most likely, they are here to **continue the chain of good** that once touched your own life.
- If you are considering establishing a scholarship for someone else, **you likely feel a deep need to defend fairness in access to quality education** by supporting talent regardless of place of residence or social status.
- Ukraine is forever in your heart, and you possess the ability to multiply good and virtue because each scholarship holder is an **investment in Ukraine**.

1. Academic Scholarships for Excellence: Future Potential

Awarded for high academic performance, publication activity, and research potential in the form of full or partial tuition coverage for one academic year, or full coverage of the entire educational programme.

This scholarship may be extended to applicants for faculty programmes, if the scholarship donor sets their own selection criteria.

The donor independently selects the scholarship holder or joins the selection by the Scholarship Committee from among students of all levels of higher education and all academic programmes implemented at kma'pro.

This format allows direct motivation and influence on the destiny of a specific talented person.





#### 2. Personal Scholarship

The scholarship bears the name of the donor or of the person whom the donor wishes to honour, giving 'new life' to that person's deeds and virtues.

Awarded for high academic performance, active civic position, and contribution to the development of the faculty in the form of full or partial coverage of tuition for one academic year or full coverage of the entire educational program.

The donor defines the selection criteria and independently selects the scholarship holder or joins the selection by the Scholarship Committee from among applicants/students of all levels of higher education and academic programmes implemented at kma'pro.

# Yurii Arabskyi Memorial Named Scholarship

Oksana Khanas is a Ukrainian from Chicago, the founder of EventusHall Chicago, the president and co-founder of ChicagoGrandGallery and MyTaxes.

Oksana is establishing the Yurii Arabskyi Memorial Named Scholarship for the top students of kma'pro. Yurii Arabskyi was born on June 12, 1969, in Lviv. He was the founder of several consulting companies involved in privatization processes and attracting foreign investment to Ukrainian businesses.

Yurii was a loving father and family man, a mentor to a generation of young entrepreneurs. He generously offered advice and sincerely celebrated the success of others. He loved Lviv and cared deeply about its development. He was a man of great integrity who did good not through words, but through actions.

Yurii died on September 4, 2024 from a missile strike on Lviv. **People like Yurii Arabskyi deserve to be known and remembered.**

## 3. Social Scholarship Equal Opportunity for those who find themselves in difficult life circumstances

Social scholarships aim to support war veterans and their family members, children of fallen Defenders of Ukraine, internally displaced persons, other categories affected by war, people with disabilities, and adults restoring various sectors of the economy in de-occupied territories. The donor independently selects the scholarship holder or participates in the selection by the Scholarship Committee from among applicants and students of all levels of higher education and academic programmes implemented at kma'pro.

#### 4. Leadership Scholarship Change-Maker

The Leadership Scholarship is a one-time award granted to kma'pro students or lecturers who are leaders of innovative and start-up projects, educational and research initiatives, volunteers, authors of the best courses (according to independent survey results), or those who have made an outstanding contribution to the development of the faculty.

Leadership scholarships are funded through a pooled model that combines contributions from various donors into a single fund, from which scholarships are awarded based on applications reviewed by the Scholarship Committee (with donor involvement).



#### 5. Other Forms of Support. Mentorship support

- involvement of donors in the training of professionals as mentors or practice-oriented lecturers (guest lectures or delivery of applied standalone courses);
