Educational Management



The master's degree program in Education Management is part of the adult education program at Kyiv-Mohyla Academy and is a kind of «educational MBA» implemented at the kma·pro faculty. It aims to train education managers who, in conditions of uncertainty (war, demographic decline, emigration of teachers and students), will be able to make effective (often unpopular) decisions, motivate others, and generate ideas aimed at strengthening education and preserving the human potential of the state.

The target audience of the program includes directors of primary and secondary schools, vocational pre-higher education institutions in Ukraine, their deputies, and the personnel reserve of secondary and vocational education institutions (teachers). They are united by common problems and challenges: basic pedagogical education and, as a result, a lack of knowledge and skills in management practices and the psychology of managing people's behavior in wartime, team building; unsatisfactory salary levels, which make it impossible for students to pay for their education themselves (\$3,000 for 16 months); problems related to the organization of the educational process in close proximity to the line of combat, temporary occupation, etc.

This year, scholarship support is available to applicants who are directors of primary and secondary schools, deputy directors, the head of the Small Academy of Sciences, and the head of the education management department from temporarily occupied communities in the Donetsk region (Donetsk, Kurakhove, Volnovakha, Avdiivka), the Kherson region (Nova Kakhovka), and frontline territories in the Chernihiv and Zaporizhzhia regions, as well as rear areas – Kyiv and Lviv regions.

For these people, a scholarship is an investment in the preservation and development of human capital in Ukrainian communities.

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
