



Location of Trostyanets














Trostyanets city territorial community:

Destruction of objects and destroyed infrastructure of the community






- Area of premises: 12 thousand square meters. sq.m.
- Medical staff: 200 people.
- Design capacity: 250 beds
- Significant damage due to shelling by russian tanks in March 2022 and missile strikes in April 2024.

Project "Completion of the reconstruction of the Trostyanets city hospital to ensure the provision of modern medical services"



 The main and overarching goal facing our community is the modernization and upgrade of Trostyanets municipal hospital to European standards, integrating high-quality standards in the provision of medical services and serving the citizens.



Project objectives:

- Carry out the necessary repair and restoration work of services in the reception and diagnostic, resuscitation and rehabilitation departments of the Trostyanets city hospital
- Equip with the necessary furniture and equipment
- To provide an opportunity for patients of the Trostyanets hospital to visit and receive medical services of proper quality



Establishment of a rehabilitation department ##ALTH GR



- The project is aimed at restoring the physical and mental health of persons affected by the military aggression of the russian federation through the creation and uninterrupted functioning of the rehabilitation department on the basis of the Trostyanets city hospital
- Task: to improve the physical and psychological health of citizens so that everyone affected by the war can recover as soon as possible and return to normal life
- Building area: 694.4 square meters
- Cost: 528 026 EUR







Capital repair of the intensive care unit



- The project is aimed at creating a modern, safe and efficient intensive care unit, which will not only improve the quality of medical services, but also provide more comfortable conditions for patients and medical staff
- Task: renovation and redesign of premises, creation of comfortable waiting areas, modern wards, provision of adequate conditions for the stay and work of medical personnel.
- Building area: 311.2 square meters
- Cost: 178 996 EUR







Capital repair of the reception and diagnostic department



- The Reception and Diagnostic department is a key center, it is there that the patient goes first, and provides medical care and diagnostic services. Military aggression has led to significant destruction of the premises, and this negatively affects the quality of medical care, the safety of patients and medical staff
- Task: capital repair of the premises, modernization of the electrical and plumbing systems, ensuring compliance with sanitary and hygiene standards.
- Building area: 424.4 square meters
- Cost: 241 448 EUR

Project "Creation of modern conditions for the provision of high-quality primary health care is the key to sustainable development of the community"



 The goal of the project is to improve the conditions for the provision of primary healthcare through the reconstruction of a non-residential three-storey building with a total area of 1103,6 square meters with an increase in its area and using a modern approach to the energy efficiency of public buildings, safety, accessibility and high-quality medical services

Building area: 1 103,6 square meters

Cost: **3 198 476 EUR**







Project "Creation of conditions for energy independence of Trostyanets city hospital in the conditions of energy crisis"



- The goal of the project is to provide the Trostyanets city hospital with an autonomous source of electricity supply to increase the level of energy efficiency and environmental friendliness of the institution in the context of the energy crisis through the arrangement of a solar power plant with a total capacity of 80 kW
- Solar power plant capacity: 80 kW
- Cost: 120 000 EUR







Project "Creation of a multifunctional rehabilitation hydrotherapeutic complex"



- The project is aimed at restoring the physical and mental health of persons affected by the military aggression of the russian federation through the creation and uninterrupted functioning of the rehabilitation department on the basis of the Trostyanets city hospital
- The implementation of this project will provide a variety of hydrotherapeutic procedures, massages for the treatment and prevention of diseases related to the musculoskeletal system and adjacent structures
- Building area: 1 838 square meters
- Cost: 4 544 120 EUR
