Problem

Currently, the admission department is located in an historical building of 269 years, which is separated from the buildings of the surgical and trauma departments, and does not meet the modern requirements of medical institutions regarding accessibility, sanitary and medical standards.

We are eager to create a modern emergency department, which will provide: anti-radiation shelter according to the latest sanitary standards, a warm box for an ambulance, diagnostic rooms, intensive care units, elevators and barrier-free access. Decent working conditions will be created for doctors.

Serhii Khrapko, Vadym Svyrydenko and Oleksandr Shvetsov, former patients of the main hospital, completed a charity marathon and covered the distance from Kyiv to Zhytomyr on foot to meet each other. In total, **over 3.6 million hryvnias** were collected over the 5 days of the marathon, and in fact - three times more, because the manufacturer's representative decided to **donate equipment** worth **11,500,000 hryvnias!**


