





CENTER FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING

Creating a modern **Center for Independent Living** in Bucha (near Kyiv) with the existing base of equipment and facilities for holding camps, events, and seminars with the possibility of simultaneously accommodating more than 60 people who use wheelchairs to gain the necessary skills to increase their independence from outside help, and to acquire knowledge for further employment, etc.





PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- conducting active rehabilitation camps for wheelchair users
- holding camps for children with spinal cord injuries and their parents
- Assistive Technology Center for the selection and training of assistive technologies to increase independence
- training seminars for volunteers, medical staff, students, rehabilitation specialists, and workers in various fields (transportation, media, etc.)
- Courses for other target groups who use wheelchairs on selection, adjustment, operation, lectures on disability-related topics
- a testing room and driving courses for people with disabilities
- an adaptive sports center to promote a healthy lifestyle for all
- and other activities for independending living
