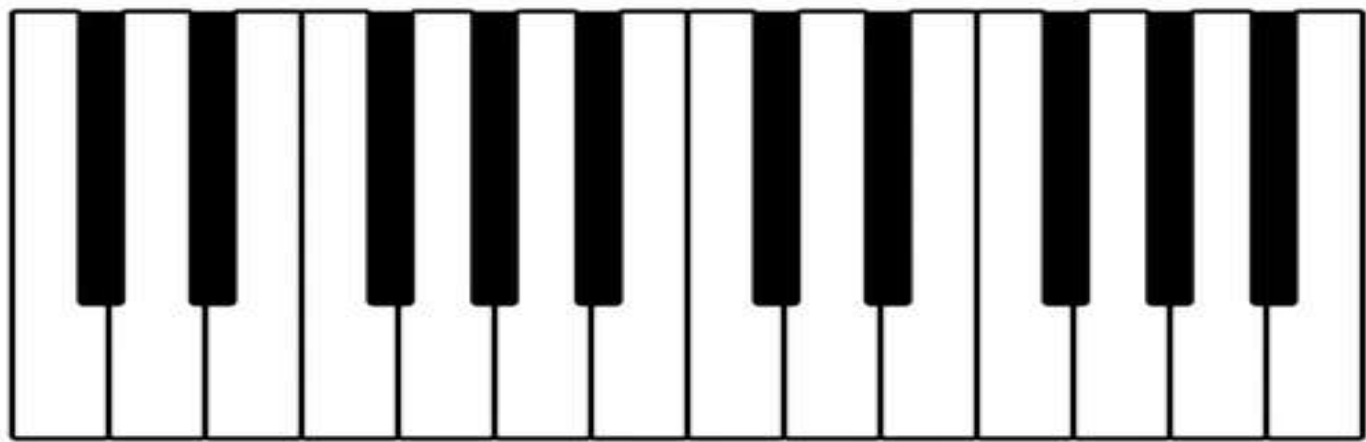


# Lesson 1: Notes

Each note has a name. This should not be confused with the act of sharpening a note vs flattening it. First we will learn the names, then we will learn how to sharpen or flatten them.

As you watch the videos in lesson one, use them as reference to label the keys on the keyboard below.



- Using the table below;
1. Make a list of all white notes on the keyboard.
  2. Make a list of all black notes on the keyboard. Please note: The black notes appear in groups of twos and threes. For the groups of twos, the black notes get their names directly from the note to their left or right. The same rule applies for black groups of threes. The middle black note will get their name from the note directly to their right.

White Notes	Sharpened	Flattened
A	Bb	Ab

Black Notes	Sharpened	Flattened
C#	D	C
