

The NGO “Ukrainian Academy of Mediation” was founded in 2014 and is one of the leading expert organizations on mediation issues.

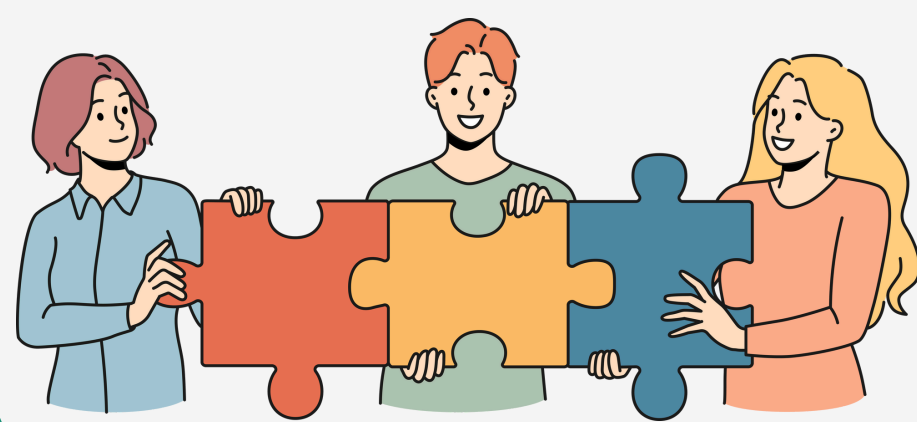

Areas of activity

ENSURING ACCESS TO MEDIATION



The UAM promotes the expansion of access to mediation for different segments of the population through cooperation with courts, social services and state institutions. Since 2018, it has been providing free access to mediation through open mediation offices in courts of various jurisdictions.



INCREASING PUBLIC AWARENESS ABOUT MEDIATION

The UAM regularly holds educational events and develops various information materials on mediation issues and promotes the dissemination of information about mediation, in particular through the integration of a page on mediation into the judiciary portal and the creation of the Mediation-Help information platform.

STANDARDIZATION OF MEDIATION AND OTHER ADR



The UAM actively participates in the development and improvement of regulatory and legal acts on mediation. For example, UAM experts are co-authors of the Law of Ukraine 'On Mediation', the State Standard for Social Mediation Services, and others. In addition, the UAM is a co-developer of the main professional guidelines for mediation - the Code of Professional Ethics for Mediators, the Basic Principles of Basic Training for Mediators and Family Mediators, the Professional Standard for Labour Mediators, etc.

TRAINING AND PROFESSIONAL SUPPORT FOR MEDIATORS



The UAM trains mediators and family mediators, conducts professional development events for mediators, and supports novice mediators. The UAM's basic training programme for mediators is the only programme in Ukraine accredited by the International Mediation Institute (IMI).



CONDUCTING TRAININGS ON MEDIATION, ADR & COMMUNICATION

The UAM conducts training courses on mediation, dispute resolution with the participation of a judge, and soft skills development for representatives of various professions, government agencies, and organisations. In particular, the National Social Service, the National Mediation and Reconciliation Service, judicial authorities, judges, lawyers, notaries, private enforcement agents, etc.

COLLABORATION WITH UNIVERSITIES



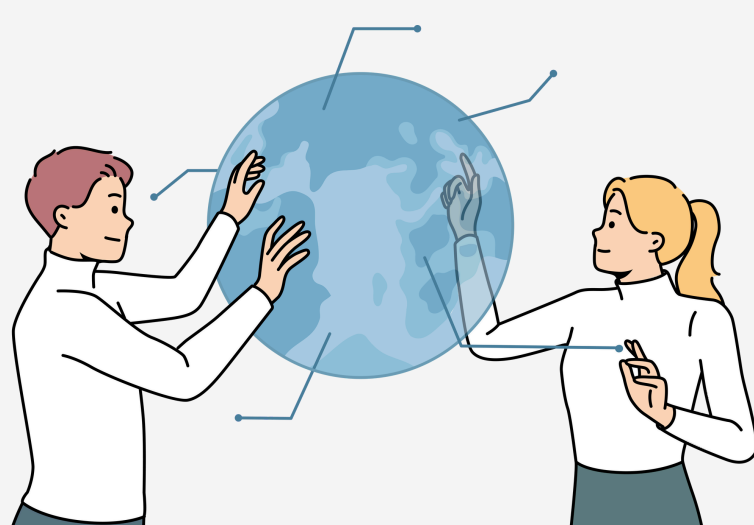
The UAM promotes the integration of mediation into the educational process by providing methodological support to teachers, publishing textbooks and methodological materials, and organising conferences, competitions and other events. It supports universities in introducing mediation into their conflict management systems.



WORK WITH CHILDREN AND YOUTH

The UAM has introduced a number of unique initiatives aimed at fostering a culture of understanding and non-violent communication from childhood. It also provides legal education, in particular through the creation of 'Lessons of Peace and Justice'.

EXPANDING INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION



The UAM actively expands international partnerships and holds events of international scale. In particular, the International Forum 'Mediation and Law' brings together about 3,700 participants from 95 countries around the world. The UAM also has a large number of international partners, including EMA, IMI, CEDR, MiKK, VIAC, and others. In 2024, the UAM established the international award 'Global Mediation Synergy'.
