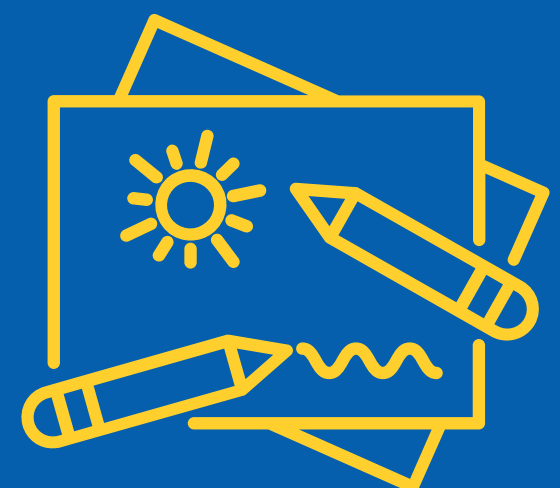
- **25 online events and 40 offline events were held;**

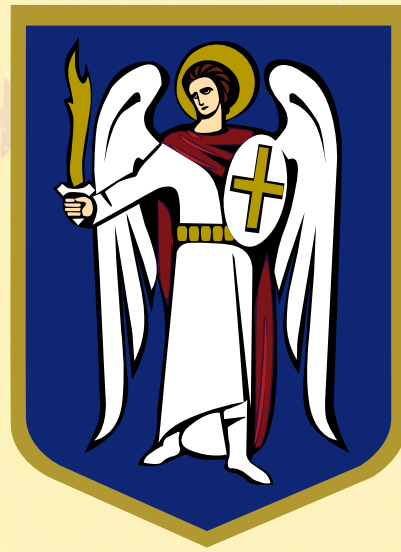
which development is one of the strategic areas of activity, has 25 volunteers

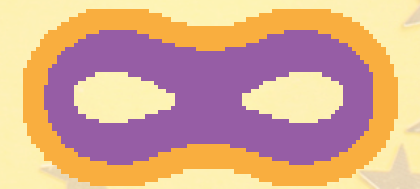
