Background

- Design diagnostic, midterm, and exit tests in mathematics;

- Prepare **methodological materials**, including guidance for mentors and teachers;
- Create **interactive learning activities** and exercises adapted to the needs of students with interrupted education.

Deliverables

- Full **catch-up curriculum** for mathematics (Grade 3) with monthly planning and core topics;
- Bank of diagnostic, midterm, and exit tests in mathematics;
- Set of **teacher-friendly methodological recommendations** for using the catch-up materials;
- Package of **interactive and engaging exercises** aligned with learning goals in mathematics;
- Presentation materials for training mentors on how to use the developed content.

Required Qualifications

- Proven expertise in teaching or curriculum development in mathematics (**primary** grades);
- Experience working with competency-based or remedial education approaches;
- Familiarity with the Ukrainian education system and national standards;
- Ability to produce clear, structured educational materials and teacher support tools;
