Grace and peace to you from our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

This month, I thought I might do something a little different. This is a spiritual exercise. Soon, you will see a Biblical text. Read it a couple times. And I would like

you to truly pay attention to whatever pops out at you.

It might fill you with joy, it might nudge you to action, it might convict you of something that has fallen by the wayside, or it might even reignite a passion for you.

Just try to focus on what Jesus is telling you. Because God is still speaking. Let's take a moment to stop....and listen.

This is a portion from the book of Romans. It is titled, "Marks of a True Christian." And this is not the entire story. (I highly recommend you read the whole thing.) For the purpose of today, I have chosen chapter 12, verses 9-13.

This is where we hear, "Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with mutual affection; outdo one another in showing honor. Do not lag in zeal, be ardent in spirit, serve the Lord. Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prayer. Contribute to the needs of the saints; extend hospitality to strangers."

There are 9 more verses also worth taking time to ponder over. For me, I was drawn to "Rejoice in hope." With all the negative and divisive things we are exposed to from around the world, this is a reminder we could all use.

Because beyond it all, we always, ALWAYS, have hope. That is the promise of God, given and made real to us, through the life, death, and resurrection of our Lord. Hope. Hope that rings eternal through faith.

But again, what stands out to you? What reminder from the marks of a true Christian strikes a chord in your heart? And here is the kicker, how will you respond?

God is still talking. Let's take time, to listen. And may God be with you, until we meet again. Pastor Mike
