

It is my hope and prayer that you will call a permanent Pastor to serve you soon so that extending the contract won't be repeatedly necessary.

Please join me in praying for that Pastor, won't you? God is surely preparing a Pastor to serve you. Every time I'm among you, I marvel at how fortunate that person will be to become the Pastor to the people of St. Paul. Your love of Jesus shines in everything you do. You are welcoming, loving, and easy to be with. Your outreach ministry to your neighbors astounds me. I'm blessed to be a part of it! Your relationship with Pastor Dan and the people of San Jose is exciting. The way you choose to be church is inspirational.

I'm being sincere. I've seen many churches from the inside out. I'm a second generation ELCA Pastor who's been ordained over 10 years. One of my sisters is also an ELCA Pastor. Together, we've seen a lot of stuff. I myself served though crisis situations of clergy scandal (*not* my own), COVID, building floods, etc. I've married, buried, and baptized more people than I can count. I've taught classes for every age group and lead trips, outings, and service projects.

Never have I ever served a church who loved their neighbor in such an all hands on deck, bone deep way like you do.

It's not just Soup Lunch and Lydia's Closet. It's learning that you spend your time outside of St Paul giving to your neighbors. It's being cautiously asked if I'd be willing to make a home visit to someone. (For the record, yes! I love visiting people!) It's coffee hour after worship – and I mean an entire hour of visiting and fellowship!

The way you choose to be church is inspirational. I'm blessed to be here now for 6 weeks at a time. Thank you for having me. The Pastor you call, the Pastor that God is preparing for you, will be so blessed here. Let us pray for that person.


Dear God.




