



Both Bridge and Interim Pastors provide Pastoral presence and leadership while a congregation searches for a new permanent pastor. An Interim Pastor works through a specific set of tasks. They help a congregation focus on any unresolved issues, where they are, and where they want to go so they are ready for their permanent Pastor. The last thing anyone wants is to call a permanent Pastor who ends up as an *unintentional* Interim Pastor because the congregation isn't ready for new leadership.

A Bridge Pastor holds place and space until the permanent Pastor is called. We lead worship, provide pastoral care, and work with leadership on specific tasks. Basically, we Pastor congregations while reminding everyone that a permanent Pastor is on the way.

As a part time Pastor who lives some distance from you, I want you to know my schedule. You can find me at St. Paul each Wednesday. I am so blessed to participate in Soup Lunch! I'm also making visits in the afternoons. I'm also at St. Paul an additional day each week that floats. 




