

Dear St. Paul.

Churchwide Assembly (CWA) takes place once every three years and serves that the highest legislative authority within the ELCA. There were 800+ people in attendance, and I was fortunate to be one of them. To accomplish business, the CWA diligently follows Roberts Rules of Order. The agenda was jam packed our days sometimes ended after 9 pm.

We passed memorials. ("Memorial" is a church word for "resolution.") One calls for this church to observe the National Day of Remembrance for Indian Boarding Schools annually on September 30. (1)

A second memorial we passed calls for the end of the genocide in Gaza and to "advocate for human rights and a just peace for Palestinians and Israelis."

We approved updates in language to our social teaching, *Human Sexuality: Gift and Trust.* This reflects the changes in U.S. law regarding marriage since the ELCA ratified this teaching in 2009.

We got medieval! Seriously, we put on our thinking caps regarding the Great Schism of 1054 which centers on the filioque clause. What does this mean, you ask? Back in the day there was disagreement over the Nicene Creed. Some people felt that confessing the Holy Spirit "proceeds from the Father" was enough. These people became known as the Orthodox Christian Church. In order to ward off a potential resurgence of the Arian heresy (2), the rest of the Christians added the *filioque* clause to the Nicene Creed. This Latin word translates to "and the Son." After thousands of years, an understanding has been reached which affirms that both sides are right.

We elected a new Presiding Bishop! Rev. Yeheil Curry has served as Bishop of the Meto Chicago Synod since 2019. He and his wife have daughters. His first name is pronounced, "Ya-hail.) Bishop Curry will be installed on October 4<sup>th</sup>.

We elected a new Secretary! Rev. Lucille "CeCe" Mills also begins her term in office in October. Rev. Mills currently serves as an Assistant to the Bishop in the North Carolina Synod. Her installation happened during closing worship of the Churchwide Assembly.

In case you wondered, both our current Presiding Bishop, Elizabeth Eton, and our current Secretary, Deacon Sue Rothmeyer, are retiring.

I bet you have questions for me and there is certainly more to share. Please join me September 7 after worship in the Fellowship Hall for a presentation on CWA.






