2003 ("Kyiv Convention")



- 2006
- Entered in force on 4 January 2006



7 member states:

• 5 EU Members: Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia

Adopted and signed in Kyiv, Ukraine on 22 May

• 2 non-EU Members: Serbia, Ukraine






