ANNUAL REPORT

In 2022, the Tykho Charitable Foundation raised approximately **46 million UAH** in financial aid and **three times more** in non-financial assistance.

Thanks to this support, we were able to deliver the following to the Ukrainian military:

EVACUATION

In 2022, the Tykho Charitable Foundation also focused on organising the evacuation of civilians from active combat zones.

In total, **over 1,500 Ukrainians** were evacuated:

90% of the evacuated Ukrainians were accommodated in Poland, while the rest relocated to other countries.

As of today, **more than 700 people** have returned to Ukraine.

HUMANITARIAN AID TO CITIES

In 2022, the Tykho Charitable Foundation provided assistance to residents of cities that were on the brink of a humanitarian catastrophe.
