

A Day to Remember Ghawth e Azam




Allahu Akbar! So beautiful! Is this the mazar of Ghawth e Azam?

> Subhan Allah! I had no idea, all I knew was that he is the King of All Walis. Al-Hamdu li Allah, now I know more!







Look! I can see the mazar of Imam Abu Hanifah.

Allahu Akbar, that means our imam is a tabi'i!






Guess what Ahad? This is the mazar of Sayyiduna Maruf Karkhi.

This mazar looks so beautiful but I don't know whose it is.


This is actually the mazar of two different walis, Sayyiduna Sirri Saqati and, his student, Sayyiduna Junayd Baghdadi!


Allahu Akbar, that's incredible! I was told


