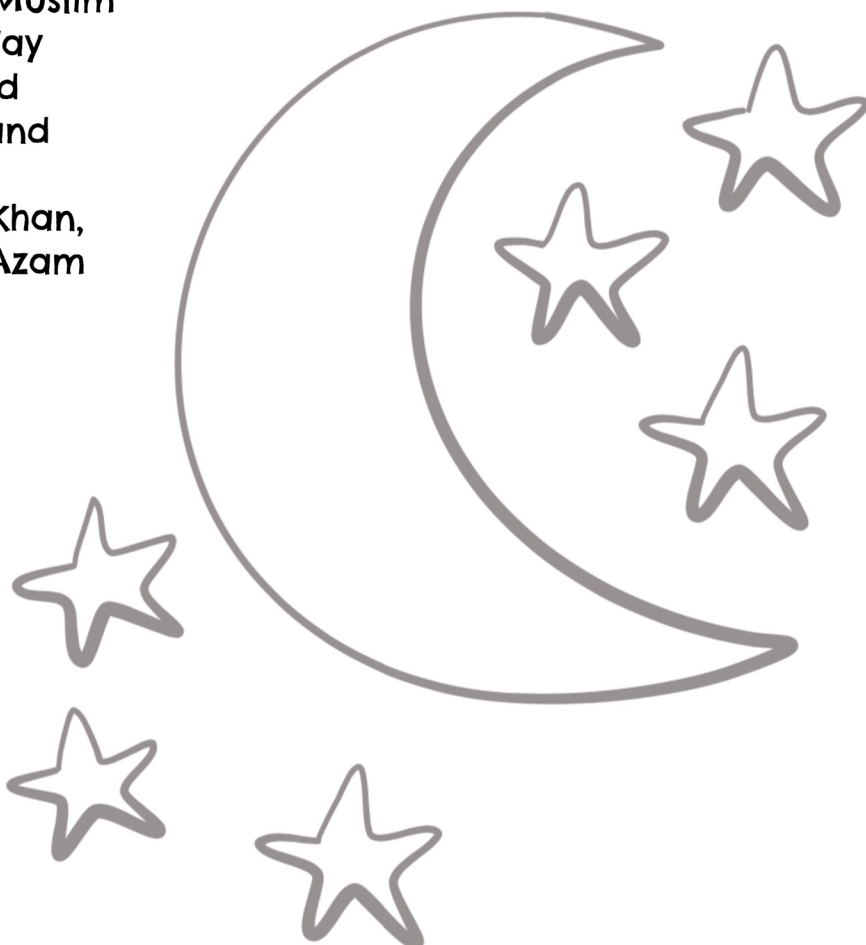

Subhan Allah! Does that mean we get to go to Baghdad Shareef?

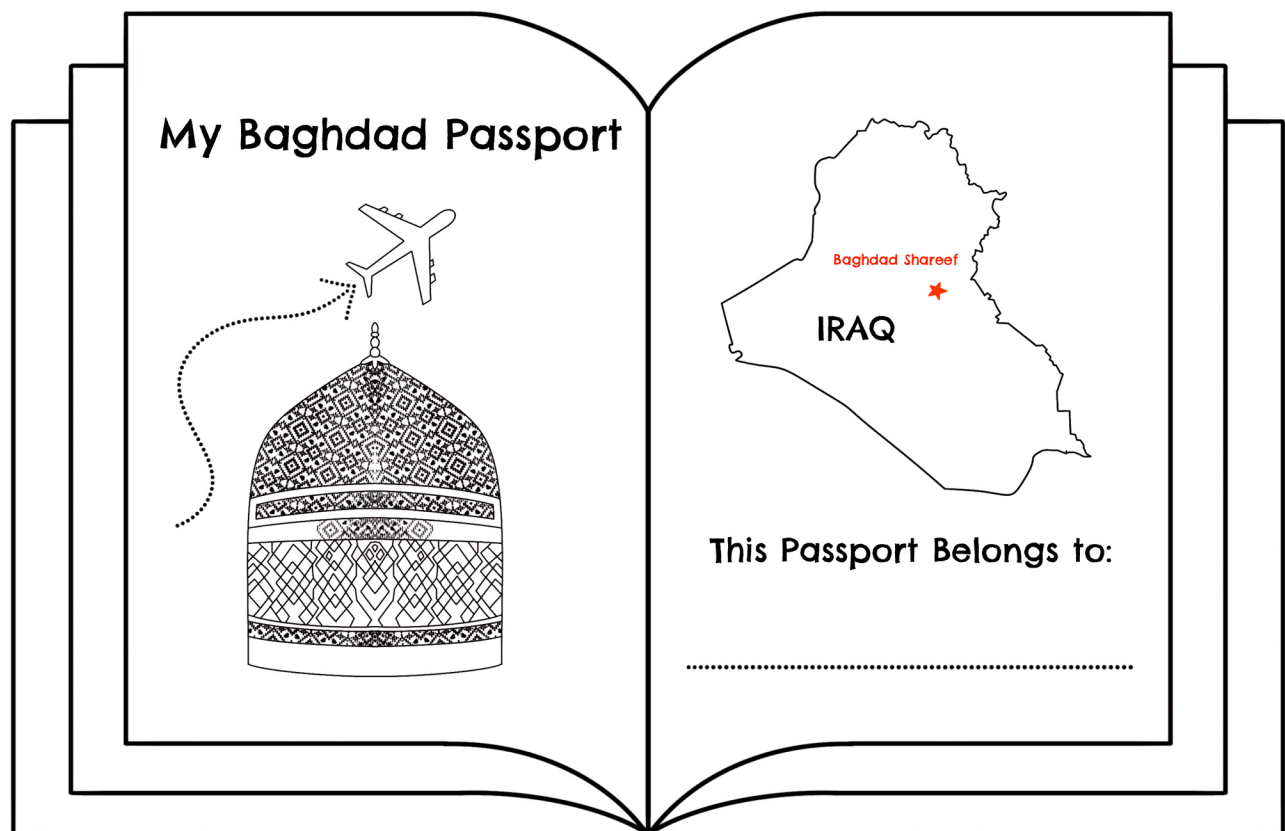
Yes Ahad, pack your bags and let's go!

- ★ Someone who met a companion

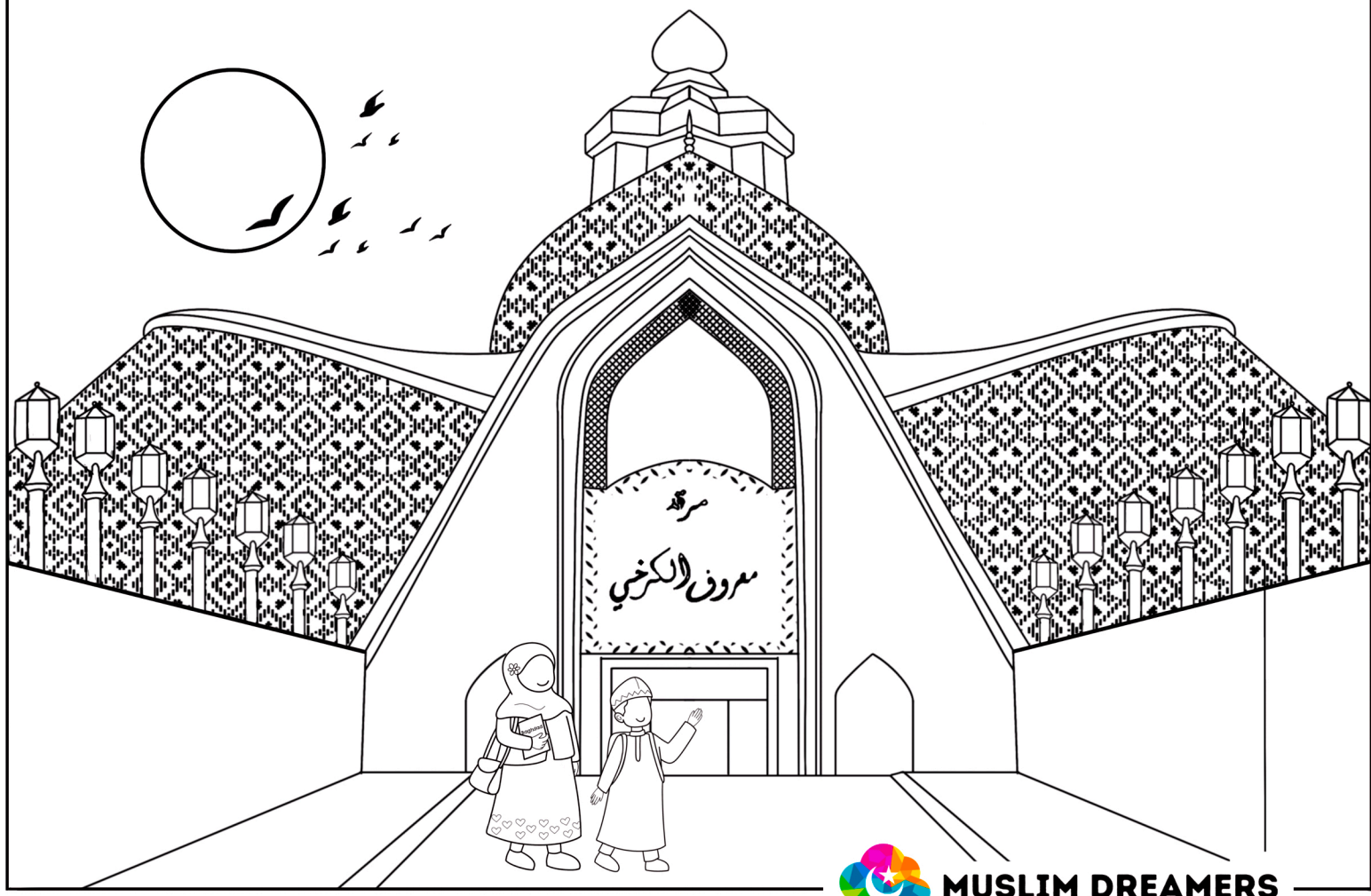


Guess what Ahad? This is the mazar of Sayyiduna Maruf Karkhi.
