






What is Hajj?

Hajj Outfits

When Muslims perform Hajj, they all wear a special kind of clothing called Ihram. Men and boys wear two white cloths. Women and girls wear a modest dress that covers the entire body besides the face and hands. Wearing the same clothing as everyone else during Hajj reminds everyone that they are all equal in the court of Allah, no matter how they look, their skin color, or where they come from.





Connect The Hajj Steps

During Hajj, Muslims perform many special tasks commanded by Allah.

TAWAF: They walk around the Kabah seven times.


SAI: They walk between two mountains called Safa and Marwah.

RAMI: They have to throw stones at three different pillars with the intention of throwing them at Shaytan.


STAYING IN MINA: The people performing Hajj also stay in tents in a place called Mina and pray throughout the night.






Spot the Holy Places in Masjid Haram

There are many holy places in the Masjid Haram:

- 1. Kabah: The most famous spot is the Kabah, a large cube-shaped buildingmade of bricks with a black cover.
- 2. Magam Ibrahim: A stone with the blessed footprints of Prophet Ibrahim, keptin a golden case in front of the Kabah.
- 3. Hatim: A blessed area right outside the Kabah, once a part of it. It is marked by a small, crescent-shaped, white marble wall.
- 4. Hajr Aswad: A blessed black stone kissed by the Holy Prophet Salla AllahuAlayhi wa Sallam, placed on the corner of the Kabah.
- 5. Mizab al-Rahmah: A golden spout that sticks out from the roof of the Kabah to help drain rainwater.



Use cotton wool, etc. to decorate the animal you would like to sacrifice for the sake of Allah!




MUSLIM DREAMERS


Scissors Twine, String, or Ribbon Hole Punch


INSTRUCTIONS:


Go to the last pages of the booklet and color in the triangle flags and decorate them.


- 1. Cut out the flags.

- 4. Now your banner is ready to hang!








