4“And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, ‘These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: 15‘I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. 16So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth. 17Because you say, ‘I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing’ and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked.

It's also not the kinda message that tells or shows our Messiah that we no longer have a deep or close love or are in love with him anymore. Getting the stick out is just a way of saying ya just gotta pull it together emotionally, mentally or spiritually, and just pick yourself up and fully turn back to God. It's his desire to see us all grow in love with him. Not make us feel guilty that we found ourselves in a not so good place.
