### **Reasons for the Signs, Miracles & Healings of Jesus**

Now that we've understood why John used the number seven in his gospel, let's get to the reasons as to why the miracles themselves were made by our Messiah. Now unfortunately today as many people have seemed to think that Jesus created miracles and healed people so they could make ministries out of the gift of healing. And sadly, this is such an abused and misled work of man's ignorance, greed and error in not clearly understanding why Jesus showed signs, made miracles and healed people. Now it is a personal belief here that Jesus still can and very much does heal people and continues to make miracles all on his own and through prayer. But sticking to the scriptural teaching we need to review the reasons as to why Jesus showed signs, made miracles, and did healings.

### **Miracle 1** **Turns water to wine** **John 2:1-11**

Here John now tells us that this is one the very first out of the seven miracles that Jesus will perform. In [John.2:1-11] we read;

1And on the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there; 2and Jesus also was invited, and His disciples, to the wedding. 3And when the wine gave out, the mother of Jesus said to Him, "They have no wine." 4And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what do I have to do with you? My hour has not yet come." 5His mother said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it." 6Now there were six stone waterpots set there for the Jewish custom of purification, containing twenty or thirty gallons each. 7Jesus said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water." And they filled them up to the brim. 8And He said to them, "Draw *some* out now, and take it to the headwaiter." And they took it *to him*. 9And when the headwaiter tasted the water which had become wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the headwaiter called the bridegroom, 10and said to him, "Every man serves the good wine first, and when *men* have drunk freely, *then* that which is poorer; you have kept the good wine until now." 11This beginning of *His* signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him.

**27**And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, “Drink from it, all of you; **28**for this is My blood of the covenant, which is being poured out for many for forgiveness of sins. **29**But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it with you, new, in My Father’s kingdom

**Miracle 2**  
**Heals a Royal official’s son**  
**John 4:43-54**

Now, the next and second sign or miracle that Jesus will create is found in [**John.4:43-54**] which Says;

**43**And after the two days He went forth from there into Galilee. **44**For Jesus Himself testified that a prophet has no honor in his own country. **45**So when He came to Galilee, the Galileans received Him, having seen all the things that He did in Jerusalem at the feast; for they themselves also went to the feast. **46**He came therefore again to Cana of Galilee where He had made the water wine. And there was a certain royal official, whose son was sick at Capernaum. **47**When he heard that Jesus had come out of Judea into Galilee, he went to Him, and was requesting Him to come down and heal his son; for he was at the point of death. **48**Jesus therefore said to him, "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you simply will not believe." **49**The royal official said to Him, "Sir, come down before my child dies." **50**Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your son lives." The man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him, and he started off. **51**And as he was now going down, his slaves met him, saying that his son was living. **52**So he inquired of them the hour when he began to get better. They said therefore to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him." **53**So the father knew that it was at that hour in which Jesus said to him, "Your son lives"; and he himself believed, and his whole household. **54**This is again a second sign that Jesus performed, when He had come out of Judea into Galilee.

**11**And the LORD said to Moses, "How long will this people spurn Me? And how long will they not believe in Me, despite all the signs which I have performed in their midst? **12**"I will smite them with pestilence and dispossess them, and I will make you into a nation greater and mightier than they."
