

## Pool of Bet Zatha

Bethzatha is an Aramaic word that means "house of mercy" or "house of grace". It is the name of a pool in Jerusalem that appears in the Bible. The name Bet zatha may come from the Hebrew or Aramaic word Bet Hesda

The name may also be a derivative of Bezetha, a section of ancient Jerusalem. The pool was located near the sheep gate, north of the temple area. The pool had five porches where sick people waited for an angel to stir the water. The pool's waters were believed to have healing powers.
