


#### Background, Objectives, and Funding

- Background
  - Locally Administered Federal-Aid (LAFA) project sponsored by the Town of Bethlehem
- Project Objective
  - Improve pedestrian safety and connectivity
- Funding
  - \$6.594M covering engineering, ROW, construction and inspection
  - 80% Federal; 12% State; 8% Local Funding

- Drainage concerns




#### Proposed Work - Sidewalk

- 5 ft. wide concrete sidewalk
- 3-6 ft. grass buffer
- Limited curbing where needed












#### Proposed Work - Pedestrian Crossing

- ADA compliant curb ramps
- Updated marked crosswalks
- Evaluating mid-block crossings:
  - New Scotland Rd at Carstead Drive
  - New Scotland Rd at Font Grove Road
  - New Scotland Rd at Maple Ave/Couse Ln
  - New Scotland Rd at Pine Hollow Road













#### Proposed Work – Pedestrian Crossing

  - o Elsmere Ave at Bender Ln









#### Proposed Work – Pedestrian Crossing

- ADA compliant curb ramps
- Updated marked crosswalks
- Evaluating mid-block crossings:
  - o Delaware Ave at Village Dr
  - Delaware Ave at Maple Ter/Bennet Ter








#### Right-of-Way Needs

- Right-of-Way acquisitions are anticipated
- Grading releases will be obtained for any grading over the highway boundary





#### Utility Impacts

- Utility pole relocations
- Drainage structure alterations
- Various manhole/valve adjustments









#### Construction Impacts

- Traffic Impacts
  - Access to properties will remain open at all times
  - Residents will be notified prior to construction
  - Temporary shoulder/lane closures to be utilized
  - Some detour / one-way traffic may occur
  - Pedestrian access will be provided at all times
- Construction Schedule Restrictions
  - Work restrictions on holidays
- Permits
  - PERM 33 NYSDOT Highway Work Permit
  - Environmental TBD
