Student Guide | English with Movies (1:1 Format)

This document explains how our work is structured and what makes the system effective.

It is built on clarity, consistency, and mutual respect.

1. This Is a Structured Program

This is not casual conversation practice.

It is a structured speaking program with:

- a fixed monthly schedule (4 or 8 lessons)
- clear deadlines
- consistent progress tracking

Regular attendance is essential.

Language develops through repetition and structure.

2. Fixed Schedule & Stability

Your lesson time is reserved exclusively for you each month.

- Lessons start and end at the scheduled time.
- If you join late, the lesson still ends as planned.
- Rescheduling is possible with at least 24 hours' notice.
- Cancellations made less than 24 hours before the lesson are considered completed.

A stable schedule creates measurable results.

3. Preparation & Active Participation

Progress does not happen only during the lesson.

Before each lesson, you are expected to:

- watch the selected episode or film fragment
- review vocabulary
- complete short preparation tasks

During the lesson, you will:

- speak actively
- analyze dialogue
- practice vocabulary in context
- receive structured feedback

This is teamwork.

Both sides contribute to progress.

4. Daily Exposure Rule (Minimum 30 Minutes)

Your brain keeps what it uses.

Between lessons, I expect at least 30 minutes of English exposure daily:

- watching
- listening
- reviewing vocabulary

Choose content you genuinely enjoy.

Pleasure + repetition = long-term fluency.

5. Clear Deadlines

Each module follows a defined structure.

We complete:

- one season
- or
- one curated film block

within a fixed timeframe (3 or 6 months).

Deadlines prevent endless drifting.

Structure builds confidence.

6. Express Format

Express sessions are:

- scheduled in advance
- structured
- goal-oriented

They are suitable for:

- maintenance practice
- specific professional needs
- occasional targeted sessions

This format is not an on-demand or same-day booking service.

7. Professional Environment

- Lessons are conducted via video call (camera on).
- A quiet, private space is required.
- Lessons are not held in cafés, cars, or public places.
- Communication remains professional and respectful.

A focused environment supports effective learning.

8. Honest Communication

If something does not work:

- we adjust
- we modify materials
- we change series if necessary

There is no pressure.

The goal is effectiveness, not stress.

9. Language of Communication

Lessons are conducted primarily in English.

For students from Ukraine (both in Ukraine and abroad), brief clarification in Ukrainian may be used when necessary to explain complex concepts.

For international students, the working language is English.

Immersion is important – clarity is essential.

- professional boundaries
